ALL-AREA TEAM

Eva Armstead, Hatton, So.

Was the area's best in three events and ranked second in a fourth. Ranked No. 1 in the 100, 200 and 400, while being No. 2 in the long jump. Won Class 2A championships – the first gold medals in Hatton track history – in the 200, 400 and long jump. Took silver in the 100. Four-time All-Area. Two-time All-Area girls track and field athlete of the year.

Ellie Partrick, Brooks, Sr.

Was the area's best in both the discus and javelin, while ranking second in the shot put. Won Class 4A championships in the discus and javelin. Brought home bronze in the shot put. Was a three-time state champion in the discus and a two-timer in the javelin. Also was a softball star for the Brooks softball team. Alabama track and field signee.

Maya Jones, Hamilton, 7th

Was among the best in the Shoals in three events. Ranked second in the 1,600, third in the 3,200 and fifth in the 800. Finished sixth at the Class 4A championships in the 3,200. Was part of the Aggies' fourth-place team finish.

Kyra Casey, Hamilton, So.

Ranked among the best in the Shoals in five events, though athletes are limited to four events per meet. Had the second-best performances in the 300 hurdles and long jump, was fourth in both the 100 and long jump, and ranked fifth in the 100 hurdles. Was the 4A champion in the long jump and triple jump. Finished seventh in the 100 hurdles. Three-time All-Area.

Mia Goss, Brooks, Fr.

Ranked first in the high jump in the Shoals, was second in the discus and third in the shot put. Won 4A bronze in the discus.

Meg Wiginton, Hamilton, Sr.

Took top honors among local athletes in both the 100 hurdles and 300 hurdles. Also ranked fifth in the long jump. Was the Class 4A 300 hurdles champion and finished fourth in the 100 hurdles. Also was sixth in the AHSAA's heptathlon competition.

Sophia Gentile, Florence, Sr.

Was the best in the 1,600 and 3,200 among local athletes, according to sectional and state results provided by the AHSAA.

A'Niya Hill, Muscle Shoals, Sr.

Recorded the top triple jump in the area and was third in the long jump. Earned a Class 6A silver medal in the triple jump. Also posted a top-10 finish in the long jump.

Ellie von Herrmann, Florence, Sr.

Ranked second in the area in the 800 and 3,200, and was sixth in the 1,600, according to sectional and state results provided by the AHSAA.

Joyden Ricks, Colbert Co., 8th

Ranked second in the area in the 100 and 200, according to sectional and state results provided by the AHSAA. Was the 3A silver medalist in the 200 and the bronze medalist in the 100.
