# TIMES DAILY 2022 SMALL SCHOOL ALL-AREA BASEBALL

## FIRST-TEAM ALL-AREA

**P: Cam Habada, Phil Campbell, Jr.**

Class 3A pitcher of the year and first-team All-State. Finished 12-1 with a 1.78 ERA and 118 strikeouts in 74 2/3 innings. Held hitters to a .161 batting average. At the plate, posted a .503 on-base percentage with 40 runs scored and 33 RBIs in 39 games. Walked 36 times.

**P: Trett Irvin, Hackleburg, Sr.**

First-team Class 1A All-State. Was 8-2 with a 2.86 ERA and a .134 opponents' average. Struck out 109 batters in 58 2/3 innings, a ratio of 13 per seven innings. Issued 43 walks. Two-time All-Area.

**C: Sam Williams, Mars Hill, Jr.**

Second-team Class 2A All-State. Recorded a .569 on-base percentage with 35 RBIs and 38 runs scored in 36 games. Drew 23 walks with eight strikeouts.

**IF: Mason Swinney, Phil Campbell, Sr.**

Named to the Alabama Sports Writers Association's Super All-State team as one of the top 10 players in the state. Class 3A hitter of the year and first-team All-State. Amassed 52 RBIs and 54 runs scored in 39 games. Had a .605 on-base percentage with 39 walks. Slugged .824 due to 23 extra-base hits. Finished with seven home runs and was 15-of-16 on steals. As a pitcher, was 4-2 with a 2.39 ERA and 41 strikeouts in 26 1/3 innings. Two-time All-State. Two-time All-Area. Alabama signee.

**IF: JM Basinger, Covenant Christian, So.**

First-team Class 1A All-State. Scored 32 times and knocked in 34 runs in 25 games. Had a .430 average with .495 on-base and .523 slugging percentages.

**IF: Blaise Vickery, Hackleburg, Fr.**

Second-team Class 1A All-State. Recorded a .457 on-base percentage with 38 RBIs and 30 runs scored in 33 games.

**IF: Cade Moore, Mars Hill, Jr.**

Drove in 49 runs and scored 37 times in 36 games, helping Mars Hill reach the state semifinals for a seventh straight playoff season.

**OF: Ethan Hamm, Lauderdale Co., Sr.**

Second-team Class 3A All-State. Posted .530 on-base and .667 slugging percentages. Had 32 RBIs and 31 runs scored in 29 games. Also pitched 55 innings, finishing 7-1 with three saves in 13 appearances. Had an 0.89 ERA with 100 strikeouts. Two-time All-Area.

**OF: Alex Glover, Covenant Christian, Sr.**

First-team Class 1A All-State. Scored 34 runs and walked 24 times, against eight strikeouts, in 24 games. Recorded a .604 on-base percentage with 36 RBIs and 34 runs scored. Two-time All-Area.

**OF: Brodey Lentz, Lauderdale Co., Sr.**

Had 30 runs scored and 23 RBIs in 29 games. Also pitched 54 innings, going 5-2 with one save, 83 strikeouts and a 1.56 ERA. Two-time All-Area.

**UTL: Josh Bowerman, Mars Hill, Sr.**

Named to the ASWA's Super All-State team as one of the top 10 players in the state. Class 2A player of the year and first-team All-State. As a pitcher, was 10-1 with a 2.75 ERA and 86 strikeouts in 56 innings. Held hitters to a .148 average. At the plate, scored 45 times and knocked in 47 runs in 33 games. Had .585 on-base and .760 slugging percentages. Clubbed six home runs, walked 29 times, was 12-of-12 on steals and was hit by 10 pitches. Two-time All-State. Three-time All-Area. UNA signee.

**UTL: Cayden Smith, Covenant Christian, Jr.**

Second-team Class 1A All-State. Posted a .535 on-base percentage with 34 runs scored in 24 games. Also pitched 51 2/3 innings, going 7-2 with a 1.35 ERA and 76 strikeouts. Held hitters to a .205 average.

**DH: Tanner Taylor, Colbert Heights, Sr.**

Second-team Class 3A All-State. Scored 41 times with a .480 on-base percentage in 32 games. Had 17 extra-base hits, including five home runs. Northwest-Shoals signee.

**DH: Greg Yeates, Shoals Christian, Jr.**

Posted a .593 on-base percentage with 21 runs scored in 25 games. Hit .476 with seven walks and 11 hit by pitches. Knocked in 16 runs.

## SECOND-TEAM ALL-AREA

**P: Aydan Beard, Hackleburg, So.**

Second-team 1A All-State. Had an 0.99 ERA and 91 strikeouts in 49 2/3 innings. With a bat, had 30 RBIs and 30 runs scored in 33 games.

**P: Henry Glover, Covenant Christian, Jr.**

Second-team 1A All-State. Was 8-3 with a 1.74 ERA in 52 1/3 innings. At the plate, had 28 RBIs and 20 runs scored in 25 games.

**C: Bryant Anthony, Phil Campbell, Jr.**

Posted a .554 on-base percentage with 55 runs scored as the Bobcats' leadoff hitter. Two-time All-Area.

**IF: Aiden Kennedy, Mars Hill, So.**

Scored 52 times and was 26-of-28 on steals with a .451 on-base percentage.

**IF: Micah Estave, Covenant Christian, Jr.**

Finished with a .500 on-base percentage and 25 runs scored in 23 games.

**IF: Hugh Hargett, Mars Hill, Jr.**

Had a .461 on-base percentage with 30 runs scored and 23 RBIs.

**IF: Landon Jones, Lauderdale Co., Sr.**

Had 26 RBIs in 30 games.

**OF: Jay Dobbs, Mars Hill, So.**

Was on base at a .504 clip and scored 45 times in 34 games for the Class 2A semifinalist Panthers.

**OF: Andrew Tedford, Colbert Heights, Sr.**

Crossed the plate 30 times in 29 games with 17 RBIs and a .464 on-base percentage.

**OF: Andrew Brackin, Covenant Christian, So.**

Posted 25 RBIs with 34 runs scored in 25 games. Had .547 on-base and .608 slugging percentages to help the Eagles reach the Class 1A quarterfinals.

**UTL: Carson Cox, Belgreen, Sr.**

Was 24-of-27 on steals and scored 24 runs in 26 games.

**UTL: Austin Stutts, Sheffield, So.**

Scored 48 runs and knocked in 34 in 29 games. Was 34-of-35 on steals. As a pitcher, had a 4.07 ERA in 22 1/3 innings.

**DH: Avery Hood, Colbert Heights, Jr.**

Had a .500 on-base percentage and 28 RBIs in 31 games.

**DH: Sage Raper, Phil Campbell, Jr.**

Finished with 49 runs scored and 32 RBIs in 38 games in the Bobcats' eighth straight winning season.
