

P: Alivia Lewis, Deshler, Jr.

Class 4A second-team All-State. Posted a 1.27 ERA, walking 11 with 140 strikeouts in 138 innings. Went 14-9 and held hitters to a .201 average. At the plate, had 38 RBIs in 46 games with .403 on-base and .600 slugging percentages.

P: SadieGrace Bonds, Wilson, Sr.

Class 4A second-team All-State. Limited hitters to a .188 average in 158 innings with 69 walks and 138 strikeouts. Finished 17-8, including three shutouts, with a 1.86 ERA.

P: Addi Wilson, Hamilton, Sr.

Finished with an 18-10 record and a 2.75 ERA. In 173 innings, issued 36 walks and struck out 191.

C: Mycah Beth Ray, Central, Fr.

Scored 43 runs and had 25 RBIs in 36 games. Had six home runs among 20 extra-base hits to slug .621. Was 25-of-25 on stolen bases.

IF: Karley Moreland, Brooks, Sr.

Class 4A All-State honorable mention. Knocked in 40 runs in 35 games with .488 onbase and .748 slugging percentages. Hit .459. Four-time All-Area.

IF: Ty Hampton, Florence, Jr.

Posted a .490 on-base percentage and scored 38 runs in 44 games. Slugged .620 and had 34 RBIs. As a pitcher, was 11-9 with a 2.58 ERA, allowing hitters a .211 average in 130 innings. Walked 52 and struck out 110.

IF: Makayla Willingham, Deshler, Jr.

Clubbed 11 home runs to help post a .750 slugging percentage. Scored 42 runs and had 38 RBIs in 46 games.
