QB: Mason Holloway, sophomore, Hamilton:

Finished with 2,951 yards of total offense and accounted for 37 touchdowns, helping the Aggies rank sixth in 4A scoring offense at 37.2 points per game. Had a 193.2 pass efficiency with a 20-to-2 TD-to-interception ratio. Injured in the regular-season finale and missed the playoffs.

RB: Cam Phinizee, junior, Russellville: First-team Class 5A All-State and a finalist for 5A back of the year. Averaged 211.9 yards rushing per game, though had one game with three carries for 10 yards due to sickness. In the other 10, averaged over 232 yards. Scored 28 touchdowns. Totaled 2,331 yards rushing on 231 carries. Also caught 17 passes. Two-time all-area. Two-time All-State.

RB: Hunter Palmer, senior, Central: Averaged 9.1 yards per carry and 123.8 per game. Finished with 1,486 yards rushing and 16 touchdowns. Overall, scored 19 times. Three-time all-area.

RB: Natarreaun Hampton, senior, Muscle Shoals: Averaged 7.1 yards per carry and almost 110 yards per game in Muscle Shoals' first 11 games. Had 18 rushing touchdowns.

WR: Jaquess Greene, senior, Muscle Shoals: Firstteam Class 6A All-State. Racked up 1,743 all-purpose yards, a 158.5 average, and accounted for 24 touchdowns in Muscle Shoals' first 11 games. Finished with 43 catches for 880 yards and 12 TDs, though ran 92 yards for 711 yards, also with 12 TDs. Two-time all-area. Twotime All-State.

WR: Eli Cagle, senior, Haleyville: Hauled in 47 catches for 640 yards and six touchdowns. Defensively, intercepted four passes with 27 tackles and 10 pass breakups. Threw one pass — for a 64-yard touchdown.

WR: Corben Reynolds, junior, Loretto: Collected 46 receptions for 836 yards and 12 touchdowns. Also scored twice on his four kickoff returns. Defensively, had three interceptions with 37 tackles. Two-time all-area.

OL: Landen Lovett, senior, Haleyville: Three-year starter between center and guard who allowed no sacks and was credited with 108 pancakes this season.

OL: Eric Thirlkill, senior, Muscle Shoals: Secondteam Class 6A All-State. The top offensive lineman for the Trojans. Drew an 88 grade with no sacks allowed and 26 pancakes. Two-time all-area.

OL: Neyland Baker, senior, Russellville: First-team Class 5A All-State. Graded out at 93% for the season, didn't allow a sack and posted 20 knockdown blocks. Paved the way for an offense that averaged over 400

yards per game. OL: Colby Brown, junior, Loretto: Left tackle was the top offensive lineman for the Mustangs, who finished with over 2,000 yards rushing.

OL: Tavarius Reeder, junior, Florence: The center graded out at 82% for the season with 21 pancake and 33 knockdown blocks.

ATH: Garrett Burrough, senior, Brooks: First-team Class 4A All-State. Accounted for 3,008 yards offense and 32 touchdowns. Ran for 1,294 yards, averaging 10.1 per carry, with 23 TDs. Threw for 1,714 yards and nine

K: Chandler Dixon, senior, Florence: First-team Class 7A All-State. Was 12-of-15 on field goals, including a school-record 51-yarder that he followed with a schoolrecord 52-yarder. Also averaged 35.1 yards on 12 punts and had 35 of 44 kickoffs go for touchbacks.


