PLEA AGREEMENT

The Commonwealth and Defendant have reached a plea agreement and hereby submit the following for the Court's consideration:

1. Defendant pleads guilty to 20 counts of Cruelty to Animals 2nd Degree, with a sentence of 12 months in jail on each count, conditionally discharged for a period of 24 months. Terms of the conditionally-discharged time set forth below.
2. No new violations of law.
3. Forfeit any and all claims or interest to all of the animals seized by Marshall County Animal Control and/or the Marshall County Sheriff's Office.
4. Absolutely no ownership, possession, control, or interaction with/over any animals of any kind. Incidental "contact" which is clearly beyond the control of the Defendant, such as feral or stray/wild animals crossing over her property or simply being temporarily present on her property, shall not be a violation of this condition.
5. Defendant shall not be engaged in the breeding of any animals in any capacity whatsoever.
6. Defendant agrees to pay the amount of \$2,523.94 (joint and several with co-defendant) to the Marshall County Fiscal
