The Trinity County Transportation Commission (TCTC) is currently seeking community members to serve on the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC).

The SSTAC plays an important role in improving transportation services in Trinity County by providing input on the needs of residents who rely on public transit. This includes seniors, persons with disabilities, low-income individuals, and youth. The SSTAC meets at least once per year, with additional meetings scheduled as needed. Members are appointed to three (3)-year terms.

Council members help:

- Identify unmet transit needs in the community
- Review and comment on transportation services and priorities

Who Should Apply?

TCTC encourages applications from individuals who:

- Use public transit or advocate for seniors, individuals with disabilities, youth, or low-income communities
- Care about access to safe, reliable, and equitable transportation for all residents
