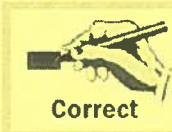

PROPOSITIONS

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the City of Sand Springs, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Eleven Million Four Hundred Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$11,400,000.00), to be issued in series, to provide funds (either with or without state or federal aid) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, improving, remodeling and repairing public safety buildings and facilities and acquiring necessary lands therefor, and purchasing and installing public safety equipment all to be owned exclusively by said City, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percent (10%), per year, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within twenty (20) years from their date?

Shall the City of Sand Springs, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Seven Hundred Thirty Five Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$735,000.00), to be issued in series, to provide funds (either with or without state or federal aid) for the purpose of constructing, renovating, repairing and improving municipal buildings and facilities to be owned exclusively by said City, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percent (10%), per year, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within twenty (20) years from their date?

Shall the City of Sand Springs, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Two Million Three Hundred Sixty Five Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$2,365,000.00), to be issued in series, to provide funds (either with or without state or federal aid) for the purpose of purchasing, constructing, equipping, improving, extending, renovating, repairing and beautifying public parks and park lands, cultural and recreation facilities to be owned exclusively by said City, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percent (10%), per year, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within twenty (20) years from their date?
