I, Joffres, Guillaume, being duly sworn, depose and say:

1. I have arrested:

Inman, Tyler 07/12/2006 69 Turnpike St, A, Allenstown, NH 03275

2. I have information that a crime (or offense) has been committed by the defendant as follows:

1. On 09/16/2026 at approximately 0646 hours Officer Chivell responded to The Moka Pot located at 8 Hanover St. reference: Criminal Mischief. On scene, Officer Chivell spoke with the owner identified as NC.

2. NC reported that between 2330 hours on 09/15/2026 and 0357 hours on 09/16/2026 someone had vandalized the business. This vandalism consisted of several broken windows with an estimated combined value of \$5,000 as well as graffiti located on the exterior east wall in Nutfield Ln. This graffiti was of particular additional concern as it displayed the words "white power" as well as two swastika symbols painted in black spray paint.

3. This graffiti was of particular additional concern as The Moka Pot is a café style restaurant which is self-declared as a safe space for members of the LGBTQ and minority communities, and includes employees of homosexual orientation and African American descent. In addition, the business is known to host special events at various times, to include events for these minority communities.

4. On 09/16/2026, Officer Choi began reviewing camera footage of the area using the Axon Fusus camera system. Officer Choi notified me that he had observed a person of interest on camera "Elm and Hanover 360 Camera - 01: Elm & Hanover City Cameras" at approximately 0214 hours. This person is seen on Hanover St. briefly before walking back east. Based on this observation, an extensive canvas for security cameras was conducted.

5. As a result of this canvas, the following information was developed:

889 Elm St. - Cameron Real Estate

At approximately 0213 hours the suspect is seen walking south on Nutfield Ln. approaching the intersection of Hanover St. They are seen walking east on Hanover St. briefly then west on Hanover St. briefly before returning to Nutfield Ln. at approximately 0215 hours. They are seen placing their bag on the floor adjacent to the east wall of The Moka Pot and appear to be removing items from the bag. An object is seen silhouetted against their pants which appears consistent in shape with a striking object such as a hammer at approximately 2115:17 hours. They are seen pacing in the alley briefly before walking in the direction of Hanover St. At approximately 0216:34 hours, they are

again seen in Nutfield Ln. and return to their bag. As they approach the bag they appear to place an object on the floor consistent with the striking object previously observed. At approximately 0216:55 they are seen removing an object consistent with a can of spray paint from their bag. As they walk in the direction of Hanover St., they are seen shaking this object in a manner consistent with which a person would shake a spray paint can. They then approach the wall of The Moka Pot and appear to make motions with their arms consistent with those a person would make while spray-painting on the wall. The suspect then places this object back in the backpack, picks up the striking object from the floor and walks back towards Hanover St. At approximately 0218:02 the suspect is seen running back to their bag which they pick up and proceed to run north on Nutfield Ln.

District Court - 35 Amherst St.

The suspect is seen walking south in Nutfield Ln approaching The Moka Pot at approximately 0213 hours. This person is seen several times in and out of camera view in the area of The Moka Pot. At approximately 0218 hours this person is seen running north on Nutfield Ln. away from the The Moka Pot. They run to the east side of the Rex Theater and appear to stop by one of the doors briefly. They are then seen continuing north then west across Amherst St. before continuing north on Nutfield Ln.

Bunny's Convenience Store - 947 Elm St.

At approximately 0212 hours the suspect is seen walking south on Nutfield Ln. crossing Amherst St.

At approximately 0218 hours this same person is seen walking north across Amherst St. from the area east of the Rex Theater then north on Nutfield Ln.

This person appears to be a light skinned male, wearing a dark coat, dark hat with white circular emblem, tan pants, dark shoes, gloves, and a bag slung across his back.

Gamache Properties - 25 Lowell St.

The suspect is seen walking south on Nutfield Ln. at approximately 0210 hours.

The suspect is seen walking north on Nutfield Ln. at approximately 0219 hours.

The Miller's Tavern - 1087 Elm St.

The suspect is seen walking south across Lowell St. into Nutfield Ln. at approximately 0209 hours.

The suspect is seen walking north across Lowell St. at approximately 0220 hours.

WBC Estates - 1087 Elm St.

The suspect is seen walking south on Church St., crossing Lowell St. in the direction of Nutfield Ln at approximately 0209 hours.

The suspect is seen walking north from the area of Nutfield Ln. continuing north on Church St. towards the courtyard of 1155 Elm St. at approximately 0220 hours.

Farley White Interests – 1155 Elm St.

The suspect is seen walking east from the Notre Dame Bridge to the intersection of Bridge St. and Elm St. They then cross the intersection to the southeast corner and continue south on Elm St. before entering the courtyard towards Church St. As the suspect walks south on Elm St. he is seen briefly holding an object consistent with a cell phone.

Following the incident, the suspect is seen entering the courtyard from Church St. and then running west across Elm St. before continuing north on Elm St.

1138 Elm St.

The suspect is seen following the incident returning west across the Notre Dame Bridge.

Prysmian – 345 McGregor St.

The suspect is seen walking south on Eddy Rd. from the direction of Planet Fitness, and south on McGregor St. at approximately 0156 hours before going east in the direction of the Notre Dame Bridge at approximately 0159 hours.

The suspect is seen walking west from the direction of the Notre Dame Bridge at approximately 0229 hours before going north on McGregor St. and Eddy Rd. in the direction of Planet Fitness at approximately 0232 hours.

Planet Fitness - 99 Eddy Rd.

At approximately 0149 hours a white vehicle is seen driving south on Eddy Rd. and entering the parking lot of Planet Fitness. This vehicle's shape, front grille shape, front bumper shape, rear side window angle, and taillight shape are consistent with a 2007-2009 Nissan Altima color white with black wheels. The vehicle also appeared to have a gap between the front bumper and passenger-side fender. The vehicle circles through the parking lot and parks along the west side of the parking lot adjacent to Eddy Rd. The suspect is seen exiting the driver's seat and walking away towards Eddy Rd.

At approximately 0234 hours, the vehicle's lights activate and a person is seen entering the driver's seat. At approximately 0235 hours the vehicle trunk opens. At approximately 0236 hours the vehicle backs out of the parking space and returns to Eddy Rd. traveling north.

Andrade Management Group - 146 Eddy Rd.

At approximately 0148 hours the suspect vehicle is seen driving south on Eddy Rd. towards Planet Fitness.

At approximately 0237 hours the suspect vehicle is seen driving north on Eddy Rd. away from Planet Fitness. The vehicle continues north on Eddy Rd. passing the 293 on-ramp.

At approximately 0259 hours the suspect vehicle is seen going north on Allenstown Rd. The vehicle does not turn onto Rt. 28 at this time and continues north. The vehicle's right blinker turns on as it approaches the intersection with School St. which is located north of 69 Turnpike St.

Hudson Quarry – 78 Turnpike St., Allenstown

At approximately 0259 headlights of a vehicle are seen on Turnpike St. These headlights appear to stop on Turnpike St. in the area of 69 Turnpike St. and 73 Turnpike St. which is located north of 69 Turnpike St.

6. While canvassing for video at McDonalds on 09/23/2026 I observed a vehicle parked in the driveway located between 69 Turnpike St. and 73 Turnpike St. This vehicle was identified as NH 5672702 a White 2008 Nissan Altima. This vehicle appeared consistent with the suspect vehicle as it also had black wheels, however the rear bumper had been spray painted black. This spray paint appeared to be poorly applied with overspray on adjoining panels. The vehicle also had rust and damage above the rear passenger side wheel well, as well as a visible gap between the bumper and front passenger fender.

7. NH 5672702 was last registered to Tyler Inman (07/12/2006) with an address of 103 Blueberry Ln., Laconia, NH.

8. CA Bevans began to research Tyler using the Transunion Law Enforcement (TLO) database and determined that 69 Turnpike St., Allenstown, NH was listed as his most recent address.

9. CA Bevans began to research the address and Tyler Inman and identified his mother as JS based on a report with Laconia Police. In TLO JS has possible family members listed as Tyler Inman and MS. MS also appears in TLO with a listed address of 69 Turnpike St. Apt. A, Allenstown, NH.

10. CA Bevans ran an offline search of Tyler Inman (07/12/2006) and NH 5672702. As a result of this search, it was determined that he had been searched in NCIC by the Concord Police Department on 09/14/2026 at 0115hrs.

11. On 09/24/2026 Detective Sergeant Brandreth contacted the Concord Police Department regarding this NCIC search and obtained the call for service information (Concord CFS #26-35653).

12. In this call for service, Officer Alcide initiate a suspicious vehicle call at the Durgin Block Garage located at 17 School St., Concord, NH. The notes of this call indicate "OUT WITH A SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE, FIRST FLOOR SURGIN BLOCK GARAGE. MALE STANDING BY THE VEH, GREEN JACKET, BLUE PANTS.

13. Detective Sergeant Brandreth later spoke with Concord Sergeant Brown in the Detective Division and was able to obtain images from the garage's security cameras of the suspect's vehicle and suspect. He also was able to obtain a preliminary timeline of Tyler Inman's activity within this garage.

14. In reviewing these images from 09/14/2026, NH 5672702 has a white rear bumper, front hood, and side view mirrors. The vehicle also has distinct damage above the rear passenger side wheel well, and black wheels. The images of Tyler on 09/14/2026 in Concord show him wearing a dark green coat, brown boots, gray pants and a camouflage colored bag slung across his back.
15. On 09/24/2026 I was granted Search Warrants for 69 Turnpike St., Allenstown, NH, and NH 5672702 a White 2008 Nissan Altima.
16. At approximately 1837 hours Detectives responded to the address to execute these Search Warrants. On scene, I initially made contact with a male at the door whom I immediately recognized to be Tyler Inman from the pictures provided by Concord PD. Tyler was immediately confrontational and initially refused to step out of the residence or to speak with me.
17. Pursuant to the Search Warrant for the residence, numerous items related to Concord PD's investigation were located within Tyler's bedroom. The bedroom also contained several items of interest declaring opposition to refugees and a patch for the Ku Klux Klan.
18. NH 5672702 was observed to have the rear bumper and front hood spray painted with black spray paint. In addition, the side mirrors had been covered with white plastic covers taped on with white tape.
19. NH 5672702 was towed to MPD where a preliminary search was conducted in which a dark hat with a circular white and red logo was located. This hat appeared consistent with the hat seen worn by the suspect in Manchester. Further review of these videos and still images showed that the logo on the hat mostly appeared to be white in color however in the Farley White video, as the suspect crosses the intersection, the logo appears to briefly have some red color.
20. While on scene in Allenstown, I spoke with Tyler's uncle identified as JS. JS stated that he had recently noticed on several occasions that Tyler had not been home during the night which was unusual for him. JS confirmed that NH 5672702 was Tyler's vehicle and that he had never seen anyone else use the vehicle.
21. Based on the above facts and circumstances, Tyler Inman (07/12/2006) was placed under arrest and charged with:

A person is guilty of a class B felony if:

- I. Believing that an official proceeding, as defined in RSA 641:1, II, or investigation is pending or about to be instituted, they attempt to induce or otherwise cause a person to:
 - (a) Testify or inform falsely; or
 - (b) Withhold any testimony, information, document or thing; or
 - (c) Elude legal process summoning them to provide evidence; or
 - (d) Absent themselves from any proceeding or investigation to which they have been summoned; or
- II. They commit any unlawful act in retaliation for anything done by another in their capacity as witness or informant; or
- III. They solicit, accept or agree to accept any benefit in consideration of them doing any of the things specified in paragraph I.
