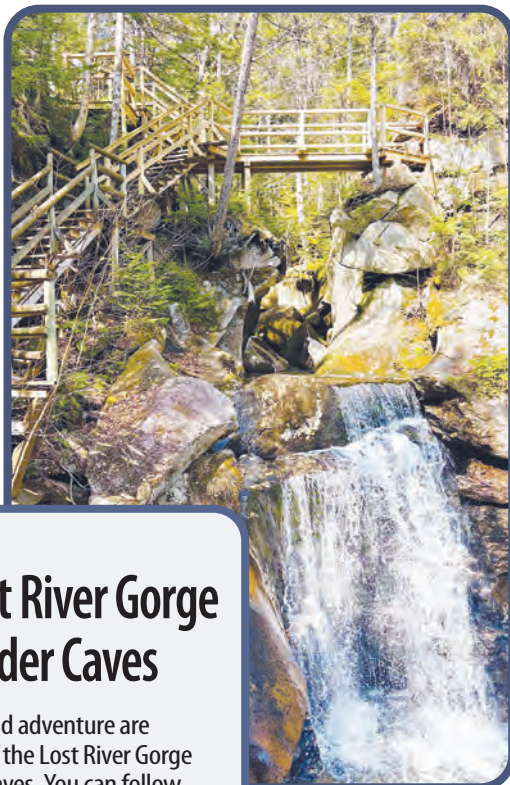

30. Bedrock Gardens

Jill Nooney and her husband, Bob Munger, spent 40 years designing and building the 30-acre garden that the public can enjoy. You'll need a map to make sure you see as many of the gardens as possible, including The Nexus, Wildlife Pond and the Spiral Garden. Don't be surprised to see many butterflies on your visit. Don't miss the 10th annual Fairy and Hobbit Festival taking place July 17-19. It's a three-day celebration of creativity, nature play and imagination.

31. Keene Swamp Bats

June 4 is opening night for the Keene Swamp Bats, which is a baseball team affiliated with the New England Collegiate Baseball League. Among the team's many promotional nights, the biggest one may be Independence Eve. On July 3, the City of Keene's fireworks spectacular will start immediately following the game. Of course, you don't want to miss the mascot, Ribby, who likes to hang out at the games.

32. Madame Sherri Forest

Antoinette De Lilas (later changed to "Sherri") was an actress and socialite who amassed a fortune in New York City in the 1920s and '30s. After spending summers with friends in New Hampshire, she purchased farmland in 1930 and built a 15-room estate. Long abandoned and lost to fire, what remains is the stonework from the original structure. It's one of the most interesting spots to visit in the state.

34. Flume Gorge

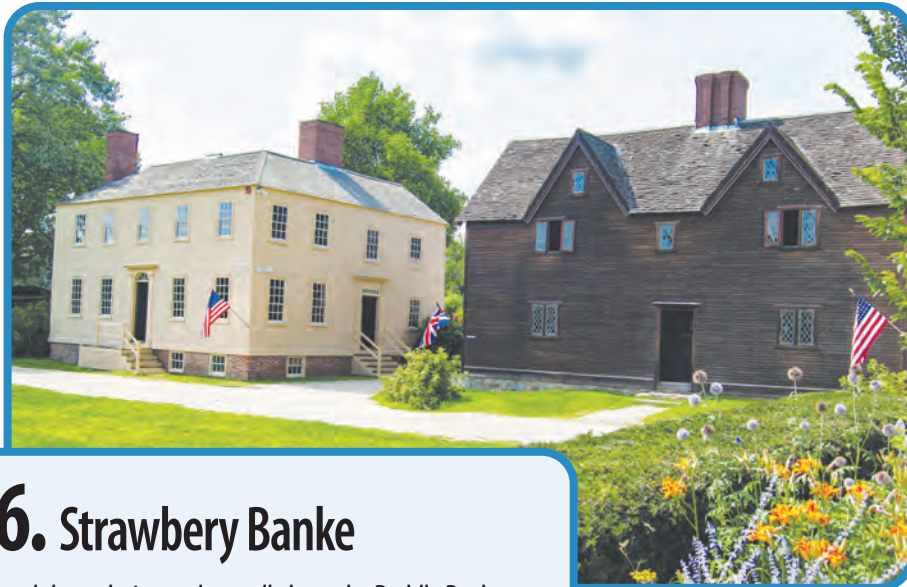

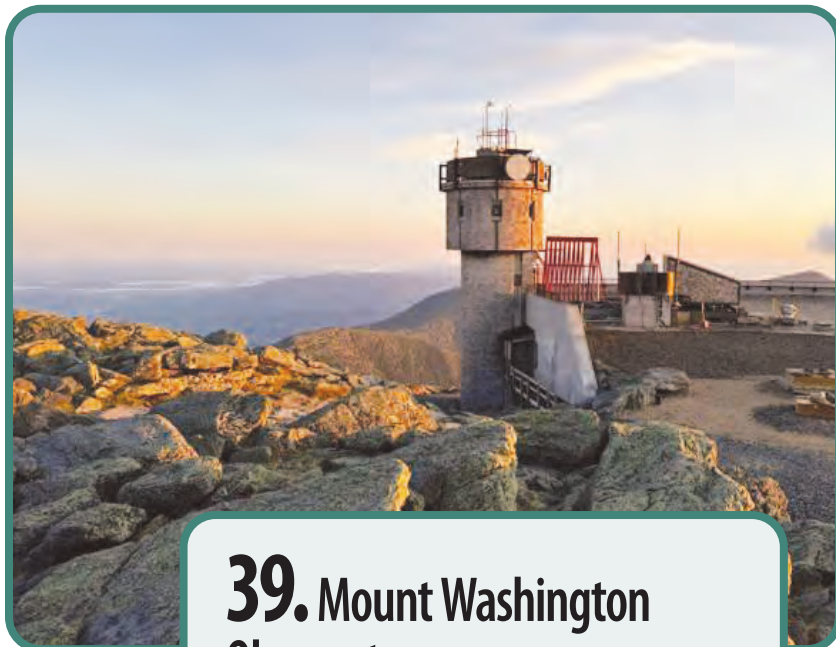
38. Mount Washington Cog Railway

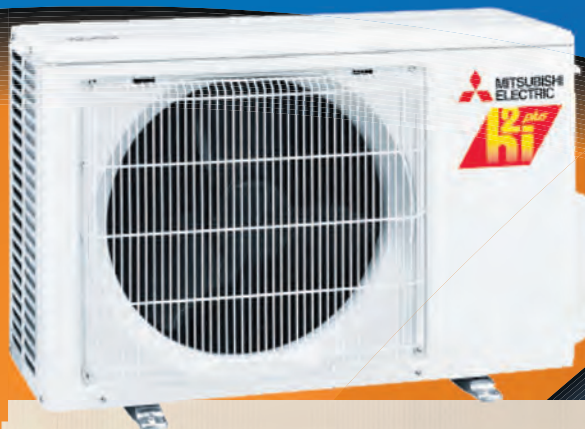

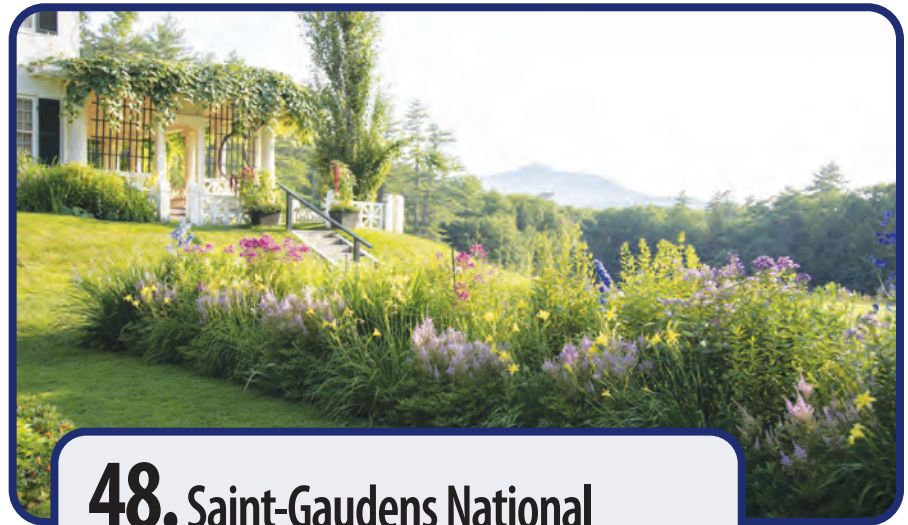

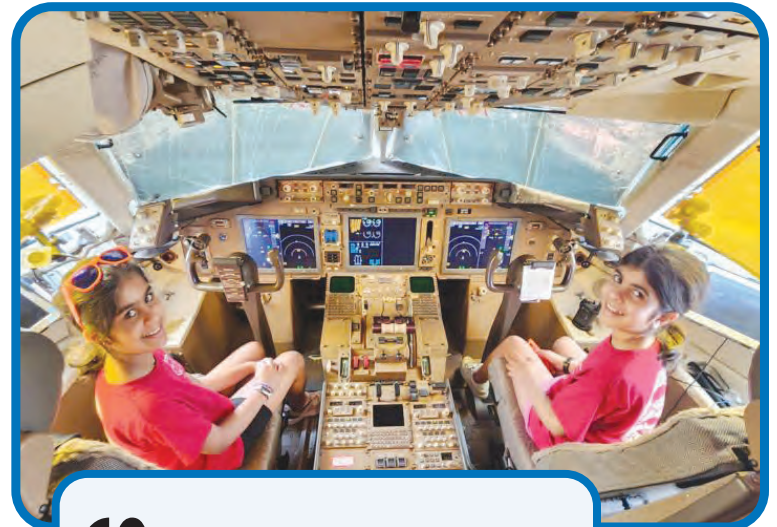
