- 1. The plaintiff moves for the Court to accept late filing of proof of service because the defendant Adam Montgomery was timely served the Summons together with a copy of the Complaint prior to the court-ordered deadline for service of September 18, 2025.
- 2. As set forth in undersigned counsel's attached Affidavit of Service, service was completed on Montgomery on September 11, 2025.
- 3. Superior Court Rule 4(c), in part, provides that "[p]roof of service shall be filed with the court within 21 days of the court-ordered deadline for service."
- 4. Here, counsel for the plaintiff filed the Affidavit of Service on September 15, 2025, and, in good faith, believed that proof of service was timely filed prior to the deadline of September 18, 2025. See attached Notification of September 15, 2025, filing the Affidavit of Service. However, for unclear reasons, the filing process was not completed and, therefore, the Court was unaware that Montgomery was timely served and of the timely attempt to file the proof of service with the Court.

- 5. Acceptance of proof of service is particularly compelling here because Montgomery was served within the court-ordered deadline for service. Additionally, a copy of the Affidavit of Service, which counsel believed was filed with the Court, was sent to Montgomery.
- 6. The absence of prejudice to the defendant provides further reason to accept proof of service.
- 7. Finally, acceptance of proof of service is appropriate given the timing of the filing of this Motion so early in the case and within days of the proof of service deadline.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff prays this Honorable Court:

- A. Grant the Expedited Motion to Accept Late Filing of Proof of Service; and
- B. Grant such other and further relief as is just and equitable.

COMPLAINTJury Trial Demanded

NOW COMES the plaintiff, Crystal Sorey, as Administratrix of the Estate of Harmony Montgomery, by and through her attorneys, Douglas, Leonard & Garvey, P.C., and respectfully submits the following Complaint and Demand for Jury Trial, stating in support thereof as follows:

PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

Five-year-old Harmony Montgomery was beaten to death by her father, Adam Montgomery, in December 2019. From the time Harmony was placed with her father in February 2019 until the date of her death in December 2019, Harmony endured breath-taking abuse and neglect by her father, leading ultimately to Harmony's homicide.

PARTIES

1. The plaintiff, Crystal Sorey (hereinafter "Crystal"), is the biological mother of the decedent minor child, Harmony Montgomery (hereinafter "Harmony"), who at all times relevant to the allegations contained herein, was a resident of Manchester, New Hampshire. Harmony was declared dead on March 18, 2024, and Crystal was been appointed as the Administratrix of the

Estate of Harmony Montgomery on April 25, 2024 (9th Circuit, Probate Division – Nashua; #316-2024-ET-00225). The mailing address for the Estate of Harmony Montgomery is c/o Sheliah Kaufold, Esq., Wadleigh, Starr & Peters, P.L.L.C., 95 Market Street, Manchester, NH 03101.

2. The Defendant, Adam Montgomery, (hereinafter "Adam"), who at all times relevant to the allegations herein, was a resident of Manchester, New Hampshire, is currently incarcerated as an inmate at the Virginia Department of Corrections with a mailing address of Housing C-+302, 3521 Woods Way, State Farm, Virginia 23160.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 3. This Honorable Court may properly exercise personal jurisdiction over the defendant because, at all times relevant to the allegations contained herein, the defendant was a resident of Manchester, New Hampshire.
- 4. Pursuant to RSA 491:7, this Honorable Court has subject-matter jurisdiction over this action because this is a civil action arising out of acts that occurred in the State of New Hampshire.
- 5. Pursuant to RSA 507:9, this Honorable Court is a proper venue for this action because, at all times relevant to the specific allegations contained herein, the decedent and the defendant were both residents of Hillsborough County as well as the location of Harmony's death.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- 6. Harmony Montgomery was born on June 7, 2014, to her biological parents Crystal and Adam.
- 7. On or about February 22, 2019, a Massachusetts court awarded custody of Harmony to Adam.
- 8. On information and belief, shortly after Adam was awarded custody of Harmony, she moved into Adam's home in Manchester, New Hampshire. At that time, Adam's household

consisted of his wife, Kayla Montgomery (hereinafter "Kayla"), and Adam and Kayla's two minor sons.

- 9. On or about April 2019, Crystal had her last video call with Harmony.
- 10. After this video call, Adam thwarted all of Crystal's attempts to contact Harmony by blocking Crystal on his phone and all social media.
- 11. By September 2021, Crystal had not seen Harmony in two years because she was unable to locate Adam despite that Crystal was supposed to have visits with Harmony.
 - 12. Crystal began a frantic search for Harmony.
- 13. On or about November 18, 2021, Crystal called the Manchester Police Department, telling them that she had not seen Harmony since a Facetime call on Easter, 2019.
- 14. On or about December 29, 2021, Crystal sent an email to Manchester Mayor Joyce Craig, begging her for help in finding Harmony.
- 15. On or about December 31, 2021, the Manchester Police Department announced a search for Harmony.
- 16. On information and belief, on December 31, 2021, the Manchester Police located both Adam and Kayla Montgomery.
- 17. On information and belief, Adam was uncooperative and refused to provide information regarding Harmony's whereabouts.
- 18. On information and belief, after questioning, Kayla reported that after they were evicted on November 27, 2019, the family was living in their car.
- 19. On information and belief, Kayla recounted that between November 27, 2019, and December 7, 2019, Adam would strike Harmony in the face and/or head with a closed fist, sometimes repeatedly.
 - 20. On information and belief, on or about December 7, 2019, Kayla recounted that

Adam struck Harmony repeatedly during three separate occasions over the course of a few minutes because she had had a bathroom accident.

- 21. On information and belief, Kayla recounted that after the final blow Adam heard or saw something that caused him to believe he had caused Harmony serious injury.
- 22. On information and belief, Kayla recounted that Harmony moaned for approximately five minutes.
- 23. On information and belief, Kayla recounted that later that day she and Adam realized that Harmony had died.
- 24. On information and belief, Kayla informed the police that she and Adam had concealed Harmony's body in a number of locations before Adam finally disposed of Harmony's body in an undisclosed location.
- 25. On information and belief, there was forensic evidence in various locations corroborating Kayla's account that Harmony's body had been kept in those places.
- 26. On January 4, 2022, Adam was arrested by the Manchester Police Department and charged with Second Degree Assault, two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, and Interference with Custody.
- 27. On October 21, 2022, Adam was again arrested by the Manchester Police Department and charged with Second Degree Murder, Falsifying Physical Evidence, Abuse of a Corpse, and Witness Tampering.
- On February 21, 2024, a jury found Adam guilty of Second Degree Murder, Falsifying Physical Evidence, Abuse of a Corpse, Witness Tampering (see Exhibit 1, Excerpts of Case Summary #216-2022-CR-02372) and Second Degree Assault (see Exhibit 2, Excerpts of Case Summary #216-2022-CR-00020).
 - 29. The 9th Circuit Court issued a court order, dated March 11, 2024, that "Adam

Montgomery murdered his daughter, and mishandled the corpse."

30. On or about May 9, 2024, Adam was sentenced to forty-five years to life for the murder of Harmony, and he was sentenced to an additional eleven years, to be served consecutively, for falsifying evidence, and abuse of a corpse.

COUNT I Intentionally Causing Death (Homicide) and Abuse and Neglect

(As brought by Plaintiff in her representative capacity as the appointed adminstratrix of the Estate of Harmony Montgomery)

- 31. The plaintiff hereby repeats, realleges, and incorporates by reference each and every factual allegation set forth in the preceding Paragraphs as though fully and completely set forth herein.
- 32. At all times relevant to the allegations contained herein, defendant owed Harmony a duty to exercise reasonable care to protect Harmony from harm, to ensure her safety, and provide for her physical and emotional well-being and to otherwise comport with basic notions of due care while parenting Harmony.
 - 33. Defendant breached the aforesaid duties, and violated his parental responsibilities.
- 34. Defendant breached his duties and minimum standards of care when he physically and emotionally abused Harmony and beat her to death in the back seat of the car.
- 35. As a direct and proximate cause and result of the above intentional conduct and breaches of care, Harmony was the subject of multiple incidents of serious physical and emotional abuse and neglect, including beatings that caused serious injury, and death.
- 36. As a direct and proximate cause and result of the above conduct and breaches of care by the defendant, he is liable to Estate of Harmony for damages for which he is directly liable and for which her Estate seeks compensation for Harmony's wrongful death, along with conscious pain

and suffering during her life as a consequence of each one of the single incidents of physical and emotional abuse and neglect that she suffered during her lifetime, including, but not limited to, substantial personal injuries of a disabling, debilitating, and permanent nature, severe and prolonged pain and suffering, permanent impairment, loss of enjoyment of life, severe permanent mental and emotional distress, lost income and earning capacity during her probable working life had she survived, and enhanced compensatory damages for the wanton, malicious, and oppressive conduct in the defendant intentionally caused Harmony's abuse and neglect and death.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff respectfully seeks the following relief:

A. Judgment for the Estate against the defendant for the wrongful death and monetary damages including, but not limited to, compensation to the Estate of Harmony Montgomery pursuant to RSA 556:9, 11 and 12;

B. Such other and further relief as the Court deems equitable and just.

DEMAND FOR JURY TRIAL

The plaintiff hereby demands a trial by jury. The plaintiff expressly reserves the right to amend and/or supplement this Complaint and Demand for Jury Trial and does not waive any other or further claims available to her.




