PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

I, OFF. JOSEPH WILHELMY a certified police officer in the State of New Hampshire, being duly sworn, set forth below facts establishing that Jared G Masseur DOB: 09/12/1984 (the "Defendant") has committed the offense(s) of RESIST ARREST/DETENTION SER BOD INJURY; TAKE GUN FROM L.E. OFFICER; 2ND DEGREE ASSAULT; DEADLY WEAPON & BI; FELON IN POSSESSION OF DANGEROUS WEAPON; BENCH WARRANTS; ARREST ON WARRANT contrary to RSA 642:2; 642:3-A; 631:2,I(B); 159:3,I; 597:37; 594:7:

On January 4, 2025, while conducting a routine check of the Country Inn- 250 S River Rd, while doing so I observed a 2006 Tan Mercury Mountaineer bearing NH 5185838 parked in the rear corner of the parking lot, parked near the construction area. It was dark, and the dirt construction lot was not lit. There have been recent thefts in that area. The vehicle was parked by construction equipment that was being used to remodel the Country Inn facing the building with the rear of the vehicle facing a dirt construction lot for a radio tower. I observed the interior lights of the vehicle were on, and there were two people in the rear of the vehicle, looking toward the rear of the vehicle, and appeared to be moving things around. I made contact with both subjects and had them walk toward me. The subjects advised they were letting their dog out, and indicated it was in the dirt lot. They called the dog, and came from a different area of the parking lot of 250 S River Rd. The subjects, a male and female, advised they were not staying at the Country Inn, and had tried to stay at the Hampton Inn, and after they let the dog out, they would be attempting to get a room at the Country Inn. I requested the ID for both subjects. The female identified herself as

the male subject identified himself as

Jared Smith 9/10/1984

Dispatch advised there was no results for this information. Smith stated he had lived at so many different addresses he did not remember his social security number. He advised he did not have any credit cards, debit cards, paystubs or pieces of mail with his name on it. He stated his license was from NH. I confirmed the spelling, and DOB multiple times with the male subject. Dispatch still advised there were no results for that information. My suspicion was not dispelled as I believe the male subject was giving me a false information. He male stated he was stopped by Dunstable MA police a few years ago. Dunstable MA police was called, and they advised no contacts with that information. I advised the subjects I had reasonable suspicion to investigate loitering and prowling.

I advised the male subject he was going to be detained, and told him to turn around, I then took positive control of his arm, and he tensed his arm up, and tried to pull away, I told him again to put his hands behind his back. The male subject then pulled his arm away and ran toward the construction lot, Officer Benway and I chased the male on foot, and ordered him to stop, and he did not. Officer Benway tackled him, and the male continued to resist, attempted to get away from Officer Benway. I withdrew my taser, and ordered the male to stop resisting, Officer Benway shouted for the male to stop grabbing his firearm, I that time I deployed my taser, at close range to the male's butt, it did not appear to have any effect, I attempted to deploy the taser again from a further distance, and heard a loud pop, the taser still did not appear to have effect. I made several attempts to move the subject off of Officer Benway, as he was now on top of Officer Benway, Officer Benway continued to shout that the male subject was trying to take his firearm. I withdrew my firearm and pointed it at the male and ordered him to stop resisting, and to drop the gun. The male subject stated, "pull the fucking trigger". Officer Benway advised his firearm was still in his holster, and continued shout that the suspect was going for his firearm. I then re-holstered my firearm and delivered several closed fist strikes to the male's subject face, he was ordered multiple times to stop resisting and to put his hands behind back, and he continued to resist and did not respond, and still was on top of Officer Benway.

I then pressed my pop door device on my vest to deploy K9 Odin. I called K9 Odin to me and K9 Odin came to me and then ordered him to apprehend the suspect. Odin appeared to bite the suspect under his arm near his hip, however the subject continued to resist, and ordered again to stop resisting to put his hands behind his back. The suspect also appeared to put K9 Odin in a Headlock, wrapping his elbow around his neck, and roll into him. The continued to roll and fight officers and was still on top of Officer Benway. Due to the suspect rolling, at times Officer Benway or suspect would roll on top of Odin's head, causing him to lose grip. I assisted Odin in re-gripping the suspect on the leg, as it was dark and with involved parties moving around, Odin needed assistance locating the correct area.

Officer Gammella then arrived on scene, and picked up my taser which had fell to the ground during the struggle. Officer Gammella then drive stunned the suspect. Officer Benway was able to get out from underneath the suspect and suspect the shouted for me to get the dog off him. Officer Gammella and Officer Benway were able to handcuff the suspect, and I released K9 Odin from the suspect's leg. The male suspect was searched incident to arrest, and a folding knife was located on lower pant leg, indicating the suspect was armed with a knife during the struggle.

I told Hall to give me the male subjects information. Hall identified the male subject as

Jared Masseur 9/12/1984

Nashua NH

I reviewed the DMV photo of Masseur and recognized the male in the photo as the suspect. Masseur was booked, bailed and held a Valley St Jail pending arraignment.


