

STEFANY SHAHEEN LOBBYIST DONATIONS

OVERVIEW

As of 6/30/2026, Shaheen has taken at least \$158,856 from donors who have been registered as federal lobbyists since 2019. This includes taking thousands of dollars from government relations executives for corporations including Meta, Google, Boeing, Pfizer, Amazon, and Lockheed Martin. It also includes taking thousands of dollars from the executives of top Washington D.C. lobbying firms such as Cornerstone Government Affairs, Forbes Tate Partners, Brownstein Hyatt Farber Schreck, and DB3.

Norman Brownstein, the chairman of the lobbying firm Brownstein Hyatt Farber Schreck, has donated \$2,000 to Shaheen's committee. The firm is one of the largest lobbying firms in the country, bringing in [\\$73.9 million](#) in revenue in 2025. Brownstein touts in his company bio that he was referred to as "[America's 101st Senator](#)," by Senators Ted Kennedy and Hank Brown. He is a [longtime](#) board member of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC)

Shaheen's donors include lobbying executives for the major hyperscalers building and operating large data centers across the country. She took \$2,000 from Meta's head of US Policy Brian Rice, \$2,500 from Google's VP of government affairs Marcus Jadotte, and \$500 from Amazon's head of global programs Robert Diznoff. Several more of Shaheen's donors have been registered to lobby Congress on behalf of these companies including Todd Webster, Luke Albee, Stacey Alexander, Steven Elmendorf, Barry LaSala, Lisa Kountoupes, Shanti Stanton, Brian Rice, Michael Smith, Stacy Rich, Josh Holly, and Ed Pagano.

Shaheen's donors have also lobbied for major pharmaceutical companies. She received \$300 from Francisco Carillo, the senior director of federal government relations for Pfizer. She has also taken donations from lobbyists who have been registered to lobbying on behalf of the pharmaceutical industry association PhRMA and companies including Johnson & Johnson, Genentech, Eli Lilly, Novartis, Purdue Pharma, and Vertex.

Shaheen's lobbyist donors also include people who served in Congress with her mother, Sen. Jeanne Shaheen, or worked in her Senate office. She has taken \$5,000 from lobbyists who are former members of Congress including former U.S. Sens. Tom Daschle (D-SD), Mary Landrieu (D-LA), and Mark Pryor (D-AR). She received \$250 from Shaheen's current chief of staff and \$500 from her former legislative director.

CONNECTIONS TO SEN. JEANNE SHAHEEN

Three of the lobbyists who gave to Shaheen are former members of the U.S. House and Senate who served alongside Shaheen's mother, Sen. Jeanne Shaheen. Another donor, Thomas Daschle, served in the Senate shortly before Jeanne Shaheen was elected.

Shaheen's current chief of staff Alison McDonald, who previously worked as the system vice president for policy and federal affairs at Dartmouth Health, donated \$250 to Stefany Shaheen's campaign. Ariel Marshall, who currently works as a lead congressional lobbyist for Scale AI and previously worked as Sen. Shaheen's legislative director, donated \$500.
