Narrative

INITIAL NARRATIVE

02/10/2021 11:14:35

(100338) LOVEJOY, MORGAN

MO: Manchester Parking Control Officer reports being yelled at by Manchester Alderman [REDACTED] while issuing his vehicle a parking ticket. Reporting party further advised that she was intimidated by Alderman [REDACTED] and would like this incident documented.

On 01/28/2021, I (Sgt. Lovejoy) was assigned to the Day Shift as a Patrol Supervisor. I was wearing the uniform of the day and equipped with my bodyworn camera. I was advised by Captain Murphy that a female subject was coming into HQ this morning to speak with me about an interaction she had with Manchester Alderman [REDACTED] earlier in the week. The following is a synopsis of this interview and the report may not necessarily be in chronological order. The interview was captured on my department issued BWC and the reporting party was advised that our interview would be audio and video recorded. This interview was conducted in the interview room in the MPD Lobby.

At approx. 0800 Hrs. I met with the complainant who identified herself as;

[REDACTED] advised that she wished to file a report reference an incident from earlier in the week involving;

[REDACTED] explained that she is employed by the City of Manchester as a Parking Control Officer and works [REDACTED] Hrs. [REDACTED] stated that this past Tuesday (01/26/2021) she was conducting her normal duties as a parking officer and around 1431 Hrs. was in the area of the Bridge St. Cafe (1117 Elm St.) and writing a ticket to a vehicle which was parked in a no parking zone as this zone was only reserved for City of Manchester buses and not vehicle parking. [REDACTED] stated that the vehicle was a [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] did not recall the plate number at this time but advised that it was on the printed ticket that she issued. [REDACTED] stated that she issued a fifty dollar ticket for parking in the bus zone, which was clearly marked by signage on the sidewalk.

[REDACTED] stated that after placing the parking ticket on the windshield, she began to take pictures of the vehicle, which is required of her after issuing a ticket of any kind. At this time, [REDACTED] advised that a male subject came "flying" out of The Pint (1111 Elm St.) and began yelling; "What the fuck are you doing, I can't believe you're doing this, Do you know who the hell I am?" [REDACTED] advised that

the subject identified himself as Alderman [REDACTED] and pointed out that he had a piece of paper on his dashboard which indicated that he was an Alderman. [REDACTED] stated that while this conversation was going on with Alderman [REDACTED], there was a city bus behind his vehicle trying to load on customers and that the bus was partially out on Elm St. obstructing traffic because it could not pull all the way in to the designated bus parking zone due to [REDACTED] vehicle being illegally parked.

[REDACTED] advised that she repeatedly tried to explain to Alderman [REDACTED] why she had issued him a fifty dollar parking ticket and that [REDACTED] kept yelling at her and described the interaction as there being; "No way to reason with him." [REDACTED] also stated that Alderman [REDACTED] asked her approx. five times for her name, but their policy is not to give out their names and she repeatedly told him her badge number, which is [REDACTED]. At this time, Alderman [REDACTED] took out his cell phone and began to take pictures of [REDACTED] and asked her how she likes having her picture taken and that he was going to put her picture all over Facebook. [REDACTED] stated that she told Alderman [REDACTED] that she was not taking pictures of him and was only taking pictures of his vehicle. [REDACTED] stated that once Alderman [REDACTED] began to take pictures of her, she turned around and walked away from him Southerly on Elm St. before turning Easterly on to Lowell St. [REDACTED] stated that she was afraid of what Alderman [REDACTED] might do next after yelling at her, so she decided to just walk away from him and return to her office at the Victory Parking Garage (25 Vine St.) to report this incident to her supervisor and complete a formal complaint. [REDACTED] advised that she had no further contact with Alderman [REDACTED] and that once she walked away, she was not followed and this ended their contact. [REDACTED] estimated that this interaction lasted approx. ten minutes.

[REDACTED] advised that she was intimidated by Alderman [REDACTED] and is worried about another interaction with him should he see her out and about. [REDACTED] also stated that she was worried as she described him as being "Nuts" and at no point was the interaction cordial. [REDACTED] stated that she had never met Alderman [REDACTED] before this incident and only knew he was an Alderman because he told her. [REDACTED] stated that Alderman [REDACTED] never got closer than a couple feet from her and never made any threatening statements or gestures toward her. [REDACTED] advised that she was scared and nervous because she works for the city and her son also works for the city and could be targeted by Alderman [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] also stated that she is scared due to the fact that she works alone and also because she has another job and Alderman [REDACTED] made the comment about putting her photograph on Facebook. When asked if Alderman [REDACTED] made any direct threats to her or about taking her job, [REDACTED] advised that he did not.

[REDACTED] brought the email that she sent to her supervisor to report this incident and I made a copy of this email for our records. I thanked [REDACTED] for speaking with me and provided her with my business card should she need any further assistance or have any additional questions. The interview concluded at approx. 0824 Hrs.

During my interview with [REDACTED], it was clear that she was intimidated by Alderman [REDACTED] behavior and actions during this incident, but that there was no criminal aspects associated with this complaint. [REDACTED] was not threatened or assaulted during this incident and once she walked away, this ended the interaction. I briefed Captain Murphy of my interview and this ended my involvement.
