ORDER ON MOTION TO INTERVENE

The Court has before it the Motion to Intervene (Doc. 21) filed by Brok-Alan Woodward-Griffith, and the Defendant's Motion to Strike Doc. 21 and other filings submitted by Mr. Griffith (Doc. 22). The State concurs in the relief requested in the Motion to Strike.

As the Court understands the current situation with Mr. Griffith's filings, the only one that has been accepted into the file is the Motion to Intervene itself. The others are pending a decision on the Motion to Intervene.

The Court construes the Motion to Strike to be an objection to the Motion to Intervene. Having reviewed both, as well as the cases and other authorities cited therein, the Court concludes that there is only one possible ruling on the Motion to Intervene and no hearing is necessary.


As explained by the Defendant in the Motion to Strike, the general rule is that members of the public have no right to intervene in criminal matters and Mr. Griffith does not fit into any recognized exception. Accordingly, Mr. Griffith's Motion to Intervene (Doc. 21) is DENIED.

The Defendant's request that the Court strike the Motion to Intervene is DENIED, because his attempt to intervene should be part of the record. Pending and future filings by Mr. Griffith should not be accepted into the file, except for a possible motion for reconsideration of this Order should Mr. Griffith submit one.
