He is 5' 11", weighs 140 pounds.

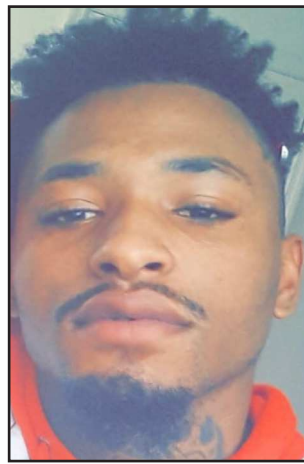
He has brown eyes and black hair.
