


Timothy Lynn Doss

Timothy Lynn Doss died July 2 nd , 2021 in Enterprise, Oregon, surrounded by his family. Timothy was born in Hollywood California, to Lloyd and Naomi (Henderson) Doss on September 16 th , 1948 at the Queen of Angels Hospital. Tim attended schools in Southern California, before moving to Wallowa County, when his parents bought the Imnaha Store and Tavern in 1963. Tim loved Imnaha and fishing the rivers, he graduated Joseph High School class of 1966.



After High School, Tim worked for the Federal Forest Service, and then was later drafted. After which, he joined the Navy, where he served as a personnel man, on the USS Proteus on Guam. After the Navy, Tim went on to attend Eastern Oregon University and Blue Mountain Community College. This is where he met the love of his life, and wife of 49 years Carolyn Sue (Kangas) Doss. They married in Pendleton in 1972. There Tim returned to the Forest Service that he so enjoyed. Serving as lookouts on; Hat Point, Red Hill, Courtney Butte, & Carney Butte.

While living in Imnaha Tim became the youngest Postmaster in US history at the age of 25 for the Imnaha post office. It was during this time Tim and Carole welcomed their son Karl J. Doss in 1974.

Tim's illustrious career didn't end there, he then went on to accept the position of Grounds Keeper and Janitor at Enterprise School District. And in 1980, Tim and Carole welcomed daughter Lacey K. Doss. Tim loved his job at the school, his kids were always beside him. Tim retired from Enterprise High School in 2003 after 27 years of dedications to his position.

Known for his unstoppable work ethic, Tim came out of retirement in 2005, and worked again, as a Janitor and Groundskeeper for Joseph High School. He also enjoyed his time driving the Activities Bus while at JHS. Five years later he retired again and went to providing countless cords of firewood to his family and friends. He took the most pride in this firewood business of his, warming both homes and hearts with his self-made business and friendly smile.

"Popie" as Tim was known to his family took the greatest joy in his family, and children and grandchildren, he loved to fish, watch boxing, work in the woods, listen to loud music, and drive all the Wallowa County backroads. His family will miss Popie's delightful sense of humor so very much.

Timothy is survived by Carolyn Doss, wife of 49 years, Brother, Dennis Doss, and Sister in law Karolyne, his son Karl Doss and daughter-in-law Deidra, his daughter Lacey, grandkids, Charli, TJ, Holly, Noel, Nodya, and Franklin, Tommy, and great-grandaughter Clover.

He is preceded in death by his Father, and his mother, Naomi passed just 6 weeks after Tim.
