

Executive Order Declaring a General Curfew Pursuant to the June 29, 2023, Declaration of Local State of Emergency


On June 29, 2023, I, Misty Buscher, the Mayor of the City of Springfield declared a Local State of Emergency due to severe storms that impacted the City.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the office of Mayor by the Illinois Municipal Code Section 5/11-1-6, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act Section 3305/11 and Chapter 20 of the City Code, I, Misty Buscher, the Mayor of City of Springfield, hereby issue the following executive order:

- (a) **General Curfew.** A curfew is imposed in all public places within the corporate limits of the City of Springfield, Illinois during the following times: from 10:00 p.m. on June 29, 2023, to 5:00 a.m. on June 30, 2023.
- (b) **Travel Prohibited.** During the curfew, all persons are prohibited from traveling on any public street or in any public place.
- (c) **Exemptions.** All law enforcement, fire, medical personnel, and members of the news media, as well as personnel and members authorized by units of local government, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, the Illinois State Police, and the Illinois National Guard are exempt from this curfew. Individuals traveling directly to and from work or religious services, seeking medical care, fleeing dangerous circumstances, or experiencing homelessness are also exempt. *All individuals, whether exempt or not, must comply with lawful orders from law enforcement.*
- (d) **Definitions.** For purposes of this Executive Order, a “public place” is any place, whether on privately or publicly owned property, accessible to the general public, including, but not limited to, public streets and roads, alleys, highways, driveways, sidewalks, parks, vacant lots, and unspecified properties.

Any person violating the provisions of this Executive Order shall be guilty of an offense against the City and shall be subject to the penalties provided by Section 10.99 of the City Code.

I, Misty Buscher, whose name is signed to this instrument, being first duly sworn, do hereby state that I signed and executed this instrument, the Executive Order Declaring a General Curfew Pursuant to the June 29, 2023, Declaration of Local State of Emergency, and that I signed willingly, and that I executed it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed.

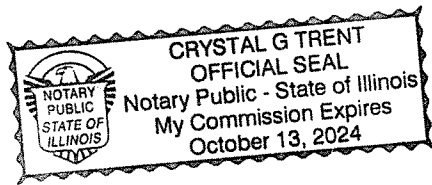
