**AGREED MOTION TO TRANSFER AND CONSOLIDATE CASES  
UNDER ILLINOIS SUPREME COURT RULE 384**

Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 384, Kwame Raoul, in his official capacity as Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and JB Pritzker, in his official capacity as Governor of the State of Illinois (collectively, "State Defendants"), move this Court to transfer for consolidated proceedings the above-captioned actions (now totaling 58 cases filed in counties around the State) challenging the Illinois Safety, Accountability, Fairness and Equity-Today ("SAFE-T") Act, a statute passed by the General Assembly in 2021, with certain provisions already in effect, and others to go into effect on January 1, 2023. State Defendants further request that this Court order that the consolidated proceedings be heard in the Circuit Court for the 21st

Judicial Circuit in Kankakee County, the county with the first-filed case, and designate that case, *Rowe v. Raoul*, No. 2022CH16, as the lead case. State Defendants will then move for “tag-along” transfer and consolidation, if necessary, of any later-filed cases challenging the Act. All other parties in all pending cases agree to the relief sought in this motion.

In support of this motion, State Defendants submit a supporting record (“SR”) and state the following.

### **BACKGROUND**

1. In January 2021, the General Assembly passed the SAFE-T Act, and Governor Pritzker signed it into law the following month. *See* Pub. Act No. 101-652 (2021). The Act enacts a comprehensive set of reforms to the state criminal justice system, including changes to Illinois law governing pre-arrest diversion, policing, pretrial, sentencing, and corrections.

2. Multiple actions have now been filed in counties across the State seeking to enjoin State Defendants from enforcing the SAFE-T Act generally, and specifically the provisions of the Act governing pretrial release.<sup>1</sup> To date, to State Defendants’ knowledge, 58 state’s attorneys have filed cases challenging the Act in the circuit courts of their home counties. SR26-1795. As of this date, to State Defendants’ knowledge, the current actions challenging the Act are as follows:

3. The pending complaints bring essentially the same claims against the Act. Generally, they allege that the Act is unconstitutional because it violates the Illinois Constitution's: (1) single-subject clause, Ill. Const. art. IV, § 8(d); (2) provision guaranteeing that "[a]ll persons be bailable by sufficient sureties," *id.* art. I, § 9; (3) separation-of-powers clause, *id.* art. II, § 1; (4) three-readings rule, *id.* art. IV, § 8(d); (5) due process clause (allegedly because it is vague), *id.* art. I, § 2; and (6) provisions guaranteeing certain rights to crime victims, *id.* art. I, § 8.1.

4. On September 30, 2022, plaintiffs in *Rowe* (in Kankakee County) filed a motion for a temporary restraining order and/or preliminary injunction. SR10. The *Rowe* circuit court held a hearing on October 5, 2022, and entered and continued the motion. SR4. The court set an expedited schedule for briefing the merits of the *Rowe* plaintiffs' claims, in which cross motions for summary judgment are due on Wednesday, October 26; responses are due on Wednesday, November 9; any replies are due on Wednesday, November 16; and a hearing is set for November 22, 2022. *Id.*

5. On October 14, 2022, plaintiffs in *Rowe* filed an amended complaint naming Legislative Defendants as defendants and adding a claim alleging that the Act violates article I, section 8.1, of the Constitution, thus ensuring that the *Rowe* case includes all claims brought by any party challenging the Act and names all defendants also named in any other suit. SR26. Defendant Welch subsequently filed an unopposed motion for substitution of judge as of right under 735 ILCS 5/2-1001(a)(2). SR7.

6. Between October 4 and October 20, 2022, the parties engaged in discussions regarding the best way to proceed in these cases. SR1. All parties have now agreed to join State Defendants in asking this Court to exercise its authority under Rule 384 to transfer all pending cases to the Circuit Court for the 21st Judicial Circuit in Kankakee County and consolidate them with *Rowe* for adjudication. *Id.*

### DISCUSSION

7. Illinois Supreme Court Rule 384(a) provides that “[w]hen civil actions involving one or more common questions of fact or law are pending in different judicial circuits,” and this Court “determines that consolidation would serve the convenience of the parties and witnesses and would promote the just and efficient conduct of such actions,” then it may “transfer all such actions to one judicial circuit for consolidated pretrial, trial, or post-trial proceedings.” Ill. Sup. Ct. R. 384.

8. Because the above-captioned cases all bring essentially the same claims against the same Illinois statute, thus requiring resolution of common—indeed, in many cases identical—disputed questions of law, and because consolidation would

promote the convenience of the parties and the just and efficient resolution of these actions, State Defendants request that this Court grant relief under Rule 384.

Specifically, State Defendants move this Court to transfer and consolidate the above-captioned cases for proceedings before a single judge in the Circuit Court for the 21st Judicial Circuit in Kankakee County, where the first action (*Rowe*) was filed and where a briefing schedule has been entered on the *Rowe* plaintiffs' complaint. There are numerous reasons to grant this relief.

9. Most obviously, these cases raise common—indeed, largely identical—questions of law regarding the same piece of legislation, the SAFE-T Act. Each of the pending complaints alleges that the SAFE-T Act violates the single-subject clause of the Illinois Constitution, Ill. Const. art. IV, § 8(d); 57 of the complaints allege that the Act violates the separation-of-powers clause, *id.* art. II, § 1; 57 of the complaints allege that the Act violates article I, section 9, which guarantees that “[a]ll persons be bailable by sufficient sureties,” *id.* art. I, § 9; 53 of the complaints allege that the Act violates the Constitution’s three-readings rule, *id.* art. IV, § 8(d); 27 of the complaints allege that the Act is unconstitutionally vague; and 16 of the complaints allege that the Act violates constitutional provisions guaranteeing certain rights to crime victims, *id.* art. I, § 8.1.

10. Transfer and consolidation is necessary to ensure the just and efficient resolution of these cases. Absent consolidation, multiple circuit courts, in 58 or more different counties, will have to resolve common—again, essentially identical—questions of law regarding the same Illinois statute. If the actions were to proceed

independently, the circuit court judges could potentially enter inconsistent and conflicting rulings and relief on the same questions. Such opinions would create confusion as to the legality of the Act—and, depending on the scope of relief entered in any given case, yield a patchwork of criminal-justice regimes throughout the State, with the Act enjoined in some counties but operational in others.

11. In short, none of these actions should be decided in isolation from the others. Rather, they should be consolidated, to ensure efficiency and uniformity across cases raising common issues of law—a chief purpose of Rule 384, which was modelled after 28 U.S.C. § 1407. *See* Ill. Sup. Ct. R. 384, cmt. cmt. (“This rule is . . . based upon Title 28, section 1407, of the United States Code . . .”); *see also In re Bristol Bay, Alaska, Salmon Fishery Antitrust Litig.*, 424 F. Supp. 504, 506 (J.P.M.L. 1976) (“the [Multidistrict] Panel prefers to place the actions under the control of a single judge in order to ensure that the objectives of Section 1407 are met”). This purpose would be frustrated if different judges could issue conflicting rulings regarding the same claims challenging the same Illinois statute.

12. Transfer and consolidation likewise makes practical sense. There is no need for multiple circuit courts to expend resources reviewing filings, holding hearings, and issuing potentially conflicting decisions regarding the same claims against the same statute. Transfer and consolidation would likewise promote the convenience of the parties, including the plaintiffs. Without consolidation, all parties (and their attorneys) would have to expend significant time and resources litigating independent, duplicative cases in 58 counties across Illinois. Allowing one court to

resolve the challenges to the SAFE-T Act will thus not only avoid the risk of conflicting rulings and relief, but also minimize the expenditure of resources by and before multiple courts.

13. If the Court grants State Defendants' request to consolidate these actions, then State Defendants also respectfully request that it transfer them to the Circuit Court for the 21st Judicial Circuit in Kankakee County and designate *Rowe v. Raoul*, No. 2022CH16, as the lead case. *Rowe* was the first case filed challenging the Act, making it the most appropriate choice for consolidated proceedings. See *Horn v. Rincker*, 84 Ill. 2d 139, 149 (1981) (consolidating and transferring cases to circuit court where first case was filed); *Research Automation, Inc. v. Schrader-Bridgeport Int'l, Inc.*, 626 F.3d 973, 982 (7th Cir. 2010) (under 28 U.S.C. § 1407, on which Rule 384 was based, transferring consolidated actions to forum where first case was filed). And the circuit court there has already entered a briefing schedule for cross-motions for summary judgment on the *Rowe* plaintiffs' claims. *Supra* ¶ 4.

14. As discussed, *supra* ¶ 6, State Defendants have discussed the possibility of consolidation and transfer with all parties in all pending actions. All parties agree to the relief sought in this motion.

### CONCLUSION

For these reasons, the Court should: (1) order the consolidation of the above-captioned actions and (2) transfer them to the Circuit Court for the 21st Judicial Circuit in Kankakee County, with *Rowe v. Raoul*, No. 2022CH16, as the lead case.
