MM: So you said she was at the right of you?

SW: yes

AZ: At this point, I would like to submit the video for evidence.

(watched video)

AZ: You said you did not touch the student, but you clearly touched her wrists while standing behind her and put them on the locker.

SW: I was showing left from right. My intentions were pure.

AZ: Do you see how that would be a very uncomfortable situation? You also do not know the history of that student and what she has been through.

SW: You are right Dr. Zahm. I may need more training. I was not thinking about any of that and nothing sexual. I think of myself as a grandpa figure and I do not think about anything sexual.

MM: Have you taken all of your Public Works tests from HR?

SW: Not all of them

MM: What do you think we should do? What is it you that you need from us?

SW: I do not really know. I have seen others assist students standing right behind them.

AZ: That is not the concern. The concern is when you put the students hands on her locker from behind her.

SW: I just don't think of that. You're right and I will from one on.
