SWORN STATEMENT OF POLICE OFFICER

The undersigned officer hereby states that on the 2nd day of July, 2023, at about 1355 hours (A.M. (P.M.)), a police officer of the Decatur Police Department made a warrantless arrest of Adam B Goodbrake (w/m 10-22-97) at 3855 E Greenhill Rd in Macon County, Illinois upon the following grounds or cause:

ALL EVENTS OCCURRED IN Decatur, IL, MACON COUNTY.

On 7-2-23 at 0900 hours, I was dispatched to 3855 E Greenhill Rd. While on scene I spoke with Makayle R Rozanski (w/f 3-12-99). Makayle advised approximately two weeks prior to this date, she was moving some of her belongings out of the residence she shares with her child's father, Adam B Goodbrake (w/m 10-22-97). Makayle advised she went to the detached garage located in the back yard of the residence to get a car seat for her child. Makayle advised when she opened the door to the maroon colored Pontiac Grand Prix (IL REG V999911) parked inside the garage for the car seat, she observed multiple bags with guns. Makayle advised she had also observed a black duffle bag filled with ammunition sitting on the ground near the car. Makayle stated she believed there to be multiple guns including a shot gun and possibly a 9 mm handgun. Makayle advised there were three bags containing what she believed to be guns. Makayle advised when she confronted Adam about the gun, he stated something similar to, "you weren't supposed to see those." Makayle went on to state that Adam was holding the guns for an inmate he met while working as a Macon County Correctional Officer. Makayle advised the subject's Facebook name is "John Redcorn."

John Redcorn was identified as Brandon J Burwell (w/m 7-2-90). Brandon was last booked into the Macon County Jail on 9-16-22 at 0323 hours. Records show that Adam was the booking officer for Brandon. A check of Brandon through the Macon County Circuit Clerk website shows Brandon to be convicted of one felony, docket 08-CF-1469.

Another witness, Tiffani M Allen (w/f 9-24-92), advised she was assisting Makayle with moving from the residence. Tiffani advised she went to outside to the back detached garage with Makayle.

Tiffani advised when she walked into the garage she tripped over a duffle bag that was full of ammunition. Tiffani advised she was unsure of the exact amount, but stated there were at least a dozen "big" boxes of ammunition. Tiffani advised she knows this because the bag was open. Tiffani also advised she observed guns in the backseat of the vehicle parked in the garage. Tiffani advised they were in bags, but did observe out of one bag was the black end of a gun. Tiffani advised it is the part where "the clip would go."

Another witness, Jacob D Stoltzenburg (w/m 6-23-98), also advised he was assisting Makayle approximately two weeks ago as she was beginning to move out of the residence. Jacob advised he also went to the detached garage with Makayle. Jacob advised as he stood there, he observed Makayle take out three black soft gun carry cases from the back seat of the car. Jacob advised he did not open the bags or see inside the bags, but advised they were cases for guns and there appeared to be multiple guns inside.

An interview was conducted with Adam. Adam advised he had met Brandon Burwell while booking Brandon into MSO Jail while working as a correctional officer. Adam advised sometime in May, Brandon had asked him to store "things." Adam stated he asked Brandon what that was and Brandon stated "pew pews." Adam told Brandon that was fine and Brandon brought over guns which were placed in the detached garage on the property of 3855 E Greenhill Rd. Adam provided photographs of the guns which he had advised were in his possession and he was manipulating them in the photographs. Adam advised he was the only person inside the garage when he was taking the photographs of the guns. The photographs were taken on May 31, 2023 at approximately 0732 hours. In the photographs Adam identified seven guns. Adam identified an AR style shotgun, AR556, AR style 22, white camouflage 11 long rifle, pump shot gun, Judge Revolver, and Glock 22 with a loaded extended thirty round magazine. The Glock with the extended thirty round magazine was inside of a Micro Roni and there was also an empty Micro Roni in his possession. A Micro Roni is used to turn a handgun into a short-barreled rifle. The AR556 also had a fully loaded high capacity drum magazine which holds 100 rounds. Adam advised there was ammunition for each gun. Adam stated all of the ammunition and guns were turned back over to Brandon by Adam on this date.

On this date, Adam advised he believed police were going to come to his residence so he contacted Brandon via Facebook Messenger and told him to come to his residence to take back the guns. Adam advised Brandon arrived at his residence and he assisted Brandon in placing the guns in Brandon's black Jeep.

Adam was asked he knew Brandon was a convicted felon. Adam advised he did. Adam was asked how long he has known Brandon to be a convicted felon and he advised he was unsure. It was asked how he

learned of Brandon's conviction and he advised Brandon told him through conversation. Adam was asked if Brandon told him about his conviction before or after Brandon giving him the guns. Adam advised he knew before Brandon gave him the guns that Brandon was a felon.

During a consent to search of Adam's phone. It was observed conversations between Adam and Brandon in reference to Brandon going to Adam's residence to retrieve the guns.

Adam has a denied FOID status.
