**STATE’S REQUEST FOR *DAUBERT* HEARING ON DEFENSE EXPERT**

COMES NOW THE STATE OF KANSAS by Deputy District Attorney Joshua David Seiden, and requests the Court set a hearing to determine the admissibility of testimony by the defense expert, Stephanie Beine.

“If a witness is testifying as an expert, upon motion of a party, the court may hold a pretrial hearing to determine whether the witness qualifies as an expert and whether the witness's testimony satisfies the requirements of subsection (b) of K.S.A. 60-456.” Kan. Stat. Ann. 60-457.

On May 1, 2024, the defense filed *Terrence Shannon’s Motion for Daubert Hearing and to Exclude Expert Testimony*. In that motion, the defense relies heavily upon findings set out in a document titled “FA1452 – Case Review Summary,” which is also attached to the defense

motion. That attached document purportedly “accurately details the opinions and interpretations of the undersigned.” Ms. Beine is the undersigned in that document.

The State respectfully requests a hearing pursuant to *Daubert v. Merrell Dow Pharmaceuticals*, 509 U.S. 579 (1993) to determine the qualifications and admissibility of the testimony by Ms. Beine.
