




Purpose and Need of Project

- **Provide adequate capacity to accommodate present and future year traffic volumes along Brush College Road**
- **Identify safe and efficient improvements**
- **Address non-motorized facilities**
- **Improve accessibility to support future development**

Right-of-Way (ROW) Impacts and Details

ROW Impacts can be Temporary or Permanent

Fee Simple (Full Acquisition)

- Acquisition of all rights and interest of the property impacted by the project

Permanent Easement

- Property owner retains ownership
- City of Decatur and utilities allowed access to property for maintenance of facilities
- Property owner to avoid any future improvements that impede access and maintenance of facilities

Temporary Easement

- Property access purchased for a specific duration until the completion of construction
- Property owner retains ownership
- No restrictions to property owner once construction is complete

Potential Reasons for ROW Impacts Include:

During Construction


- Driveway and entrance reconstruction
- Roadway reconstruction earthwork grading

Final Conditions


- Roadway construction and widening
- Retaining walls and bridge
- Relocated utilities




Pre-Stage

Construction:

- Building Demolition
- Utility Relocations

Traffic Impacts:

- Short-Term Lane Closures

Stage 1

Construction:

- IC RR Realignment
- Cemetery Access Road
- James Street
- South Brush College Road

Traffic Impacts:

- Brush College Road Closed South of Olive Street (Use South Detour)

Stage 2

Construction:

- Jug Handle Connector
- Logan Street
- E Harrison (West Leg)

Traffic Impacts:

- Brush College Road Open
- Short-Term Lane Closures

Stage 3

Construction:

- Bridge over Faries Pkwy
- Brush College Roadway and Retaining Walls

Traffic Impacts:

- Brush College Road Closed Between Olive and E Harrison St (Use Connector Road and North Detour)

Stage 4a-b

Construction:

- North Brush College Road
- Faries Parkway
- E Harrison Rd (East Leg)

Traffic Impacts:

- Brush College Road Open
- Short Term Lane Closures
- Faries Parkway Narrowed (1 Lane Open In Each Direction)





Project Schedule

Phase I

Timeline:
2010-2015 (5 years)

Preliminary Engineering

- Preliminary design engineering/ alternative analysis
- Environmental studies
- Public and agency coordination

Apply for and receive design and construction federal funding support for the Brush College Road Overpass at Faries Parkway and NS Railroad Project.

Phase II

Timeline:
2019-2021* (2½ years)*

Final Engineering

- Final design
- Contract plans
- Land acquisition

Phase III

Timeline:
2021*-2023* (2½ years)*

Construction

- Utility relocation, railroad realignment, and roadway, bridge, and retaining wall construction

Next Steps

Complete Phase II final engineering

Final submittal of Phase II plans for construction

Contractor bidding and selection
