### OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

Item Number	Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below.
	Follow up visit for rodent activity that was present in Aisle 10 during investigation to complaints F-4164 (received on 3/25/2021) and F-4168 (received on 4/15/2021). Both complaints involved signs of rodent activity (mouse droppings) on shelving, boxes, and tops of canned goods in Aisle 10.
	During investigation to complaints F-4164/F-4168 on 4/7/2021, heavy mouse droppings were observed on the floor, shelving, boxes for packaged product, and on tops of canned goods in Aisle 10. Management was informed of situation and issue was escalated to pest management to schedule service. Instructions were given to remove rodent dropping, clean/sanitize shelving and clean/remove affected food product. To allow proper time to address sanitation measures, a follow up of 5 Days was granted. Follow up visit of 4/14/2021 was stated on report and acknowledged by management.
	During follow up inspection (4/14/2021), live and deceased rodent activity was observed in the following areas: 1) Deli Fresh Department (2 deceased mice in multiple catch trap) 2) Bakery Fresh Department (1 live mouse near walk-in freezer/dry storage area) 3) Grocery/Receiving (1 live and 1 deceased mouse in multiple catch trap) 4) Sales Floor (Aisle 7) (3 deceased mice on glueboard trap) 5) Sales Floor (Aisle 10) (2 deceased mice on glueboard trap)
	Heavy rodent droppings/urine stains observed on canned goods in Aisles 7 and 10. Aisle 7 was area of concern for Complaint F-4147 that was received on 1/12/2021 from customer observing mouse droppings and chewed up packages. Droppings were also present in the following areas identifying that facility has an active rodent infestation: 1) Deli Fresh Department (Behind coils line equipment and deli display cases) 2) Bakery Fresh Department (Under prep tables and behind oven/proofer) 3) Sales floor (Floors under dry storage and refrigerated units of Aisles 7 thru 10) 4) Grocery/Receiving (Behind equipment/storage near back wall of facility) 5) Electrical Panel/Utility Room floors

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

### OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

Item Number	Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below.
	<p>Manager provided reports from pest control that provided service on 4/7, 4/8, and 4/13. During follow up pest control arrived to provide additional service. Glueboard style traps were placed on the sales floor to monitor activity and areas inspected for signs of activity. After service was provided on 4/14/2021, two glueboard style traps were found with a total of 3 deceased mice (Aisles 7 and 10)</p> <p>Due to evidence of rodent activity present during investigation, infestation of mouse activity has been deemed an imminent health hazard and facility has been closed effective immediately. Presence of live rodent activity, droppings / urine on packaged / canned products, and chewed open (contaminated) product all increase risk of the spread of pathogens.</p> <p>Location will remain closed until the necessary steps list below are in place to reduce risk of cross-contamination</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Effective pest control program to eliminate rodent activity and provide measures to monitor / prevent future infestations.</li> <li>2) Deep cleaning of fresh departments (Bakery/Deli) where active food prep occurs.</li> <li>3) Removal of affected food product off the sales floor including deep cleaning of all affected floors / shelving of food shelving.</li> </ol> <p>Corrective action plan must be submitted to the Macon County Health Department to be reviewed and approved listing steps taken to resolve all issues that resulted in closure of facility. Fine of \$250.00 must also be submitted prior to re-opening.</p> <p>Although the sale of food has been temporarily suspended, the following items and location is allowed to operate.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Pharmacy Department</li> <li>2) Liquor and Tobacco</li> <li>3) Chemicals / Cleaning Supplies</li> <li>4) Lotto</li> </ol> <p>Once all requirements are met, please contact the Macon County Health Department at (217) 423-6988 to schedule re-opening inspection + HACCP: Pest Control + Follow Up: Will Call</p>

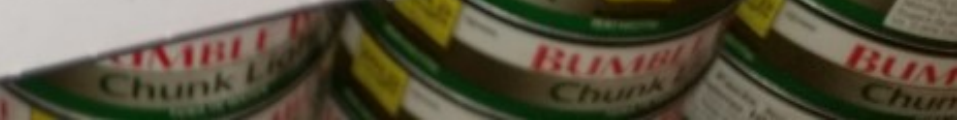
