I am writing on behalf of Mayville Engineering Company, Inc. to give you notice that there will be a total closure of the Mayville Engineering Company Wautoma Facility located at 431 E. Division Street, Wautoma, Wisconsin 54982. This closure is expected to affect the entire facility and to be permanent.

The following is a list of the job positions and the number of individuals who will be affected by the closure. The following job losses will occur on November 16, 2024:

- Metal Finisher – 2
- Production Lead – 3
- Quality Assurance Technician – 2
- Welder – 19

The following job losses will occur on November 22, 2024:

- Material Coordinator – 1
- Painter – 1
- Production Operator – 7
- Production Support Coordinator – 1
- Quality Assurance Technician – 1
- Shipping/Receiving Coordinator – 1
- Tube Bender Operator – 1
- Welder – 3

The following job loss will occur on January 31, 2025:

- Production Manager - 1

There will not be any bumping rights for the affected employees. That is, employees will not be able to displace more junior employees out of their job positions as a result of this closure. There is no union representing the affected employees.
