Ref: Case# 26.004379 ***UPDATE*** Aggravated Assault against Public Servant

On Thursday, February 26, 2026, at approximately 0322 hours, an Ellis County Deputy observed a vehicle shooting from the roadway near FM 875 and FM 663 in Midlothian, Ellis County. When the deputy attempted to conduct a traffic stop, the driver fled, initiating a pursuit during which the occupants of the vehicle discharged firearms at responding deputies and additional assisting agencies.

Through coordinated efforts with our law enforcement partners, the pursuit extended into neighboring jurisdictions and was ultimately ended after the Fort Worth Police Department successfully deployed spikes strips. A short distance later the vehicle crashed.

Following the crash, investigators secured the scene and executed a search warrant on the vehicle. Through corroborating evidence collected at the crash site and evidence obtained during the search warrant, along with interviews, investigators developed probable cause to criminally charge all five occupants.





Fernando Alba Jr. (26 YOA) is currently in the ICU and is expected to be released soon. Upon his release, he will be transported to the Ellis County Jail where he will be formally charged with Aggravated Assault against a Public Servant, Possession of Marijuana over 4 ounces LT or equal to 5 pounds, Possession of a Controlled Substance PG1 LT 1G, Felon in Possession of Firearm and Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle.

This successful apprehension would not have been possible without the professionalism, courage, and coordinated response of the Fort Worth Police Department and the neighboring agencies who assisted during this dangerous pursuit. Their partnership, swift action, and seamless coordination were instrumental in bringing this violent situation to a safe conclusion.

This investigation remains ongoing, and additional charges may be forthcoming not only from the Ellis County Sheriff's Office but also from the neighboring agencies involved in the apprehension.

I commend our deputies and our law enforcement partners for their bravery, restraint, and unwavering commitment to protecting the citizens of both Ellis and Tarrant County. Their actions reflect the highest standards of law enforcement service.
