



**Applicant:** Chris Reeves, Quickway Signs

Property Address: 217 E. Main Street

**Request:** The Applicant proposes to replace the window and door vinyl signage with the proposed signage to meet the city's sign requirements. The signage will consist of the same design but will be smaller in size. The revised signage complies with the city's minimum signage requirements.

- Left Window Vinyl Sign:  $2.3' \times 7.8' = 18.3 \text{ sf (max. 19 sf)}$
- Right Window Vinyl Sign:  $2.3' \times 6.8' = 15.9 \text{ sf (max. } 17 \text{ sf)}$
- Left Door Vinyl Sign: 1.7' x 2.5' = 4.2 sf (max. 5.4 sf)
- Right Door Vinyl Sign:  $1.7' \times 2.5' = 4.2 \text{ sf (max. } 5.4 \text{ sf)}$

Additionally, the Applicant is requesting approval for a blade sign measuring 4 feet by 2 feet. The proposed sign complies with the city's minimum signage requirements.

#### **Conditions of Approval:**

- The Applicant must replace the nonconforming signage with the approved signage within 30 days of receiving HPC approval.
- The Applicant shall apply for all required permits from the City in accordance with the City's applicable rules and regulations governing such permits.
- The Applicant must notify the Heritage Preservation Commission when improvements are completed so that the Chair may verify that they were completed in accordance with HPC approval.



**Applicant:** Juan Garcia De La Torre, FastSigns

Property Address: 301 N. College Street

**Request:** The applicant proposes installing two signs on the building. The first sign, measuring 4 feet by 5 feet, will be mounted on the façade facing the AT&T building to the north of the property. The second sign, measuring 2.5 feet by 10 feet, will be placed on the façade facing the railroad tracks.

The signs will be constructed using aluminum composite material (ACM) from the Dibond brand. Additionally, the applicant has agreed to install the screws for anchoring the sign in the mortar joints rather than the face of the brick. As proposed the sign meet the City's minimum sign requirements.

#### **Conditions of Approval:**


- The Applicant shall apply for all required permits from the City in accordance with the City's applicable rules and regulations governing such permits.
- The screws used to anchor the sign will be installed in the mortar joints instead of directly into the face of the brick.
