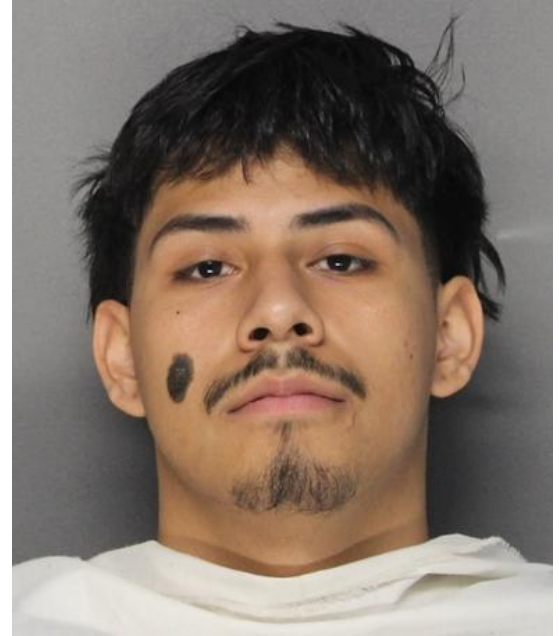

Ref: Case# 26.008215 – Murder Arrest in Ellis County

On Sunday, April 5, 2026, at approximately 0233 hours, Deputies with the Ellis County Sheriff's Office responded to the 200 block of Hearne Lane in Red Oak, Ellis County, Texas on a reported shooting involving an adult male victim who sustained a gunshot wound. The victim was airlifted to Parkland Hospital, where he unfortunately succumbed to his injuries.

Investigators with the Ellis County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division responded to the scene, where they processed evidence and conducted multiple witness interviews. Through the course of the investigation, and based on evidence recovered at the scene, the suspect was identified as **Pantalion Lucio**, a 19-year-old male from Dallas. A warrant for Murder was subsequently obtained, and a reviewing magistrate issued a preset bond of \$1,000,000.



With the assistance of the Office of the Attorney General Fugitive Task Force, Lucio was located in Dallas and taken into custody at his residence. This arrest would not have been possible without the coordinated efforts and professionalism of our partner agencies.

I would like to extend my sincere appreciation to the Red Oak Police Department, Dallas County Sheriff's Office, Dallas Police Department, and especially the Office of the Attorney General Fugitive Task Force for their assistance in safely apprehending the suspect. This investigation remains ongoing.
