NOTICE OF ADVICE OF RIGHT TO COUNSEL FOR ALL JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

- 1. This paper charges you with committing a crime.
- 2. If you have been arrested and remain in custody, you have the right to have a judicial officer decide whether you should be released from jail until your trial.
- 3. If you have been served with a citation or summons directing you to appear before a judicial officer for a preliminary inquiry at a date and time designated or within five days of service if no time is designated, a judicial officer will advise you of your rights, the charges against you, and penalties. The preliminary inquiry will be cancelled if a lawyer has entered an appearance to represent you.
- 4. You have the right to have a lawyer.
- 5. A lawyer can be helpful to you by:
 - (A) explaining the charges in this paper:
 - (B) telling you the possible penalties;
 - (C) helping you at trial;
 - (D) helping you protect your constitutional rights; and
 - (E) helping you to get a fair penalty if convicted.
- 6. Even if you plan to plead guilty, a lawyer can be helpful.
- 7. If you are eligible, the Public Defender or a court-appointed attorney will represent you at any initial appearance before a judicial officer and at any proceeding under Rule 4-216.1 to review an order of a District Court commissioner regarding pretrial release. If you want a lawyer for any further proceeding, including trial, but do not have the money to hire one, the Public Defender may provide a lawyer for you. The court clerk will tell you how to contact the Public Defender.
- 8. If you want a lawyer but you cannot get one and the Public Defender will not provide one for you, contact the court clerk as soon as possible.
- 9. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DATE OF YOUR TRIAL TO GET A LAWYER. If you do not have a lawyer before the trial date, you may have to go to trial without one.

On October 30, 2022, at approximately 1156 hours, I, Detective C. Kirkpatrick, was notified that the Road Patrol Supervisor was requesting a Detective to interview a female victim of a sexual assault. I was notified that the female began speaking to Sgt. H. Phillips, who thought she was there to file a complaint on a Deputy. Once the female victim, J.A. (3/1/95), began describing a sexual assault, Sgt. Phillips decided to stop talking to her and request the Criminal Investigation Division to assist.

Upon arrival I conducted a recorded interview with J.A., who was visibly upset and shaking as she spoke. J.A. described being in the parking lot of the Kohl's Department Store, meeting a friend, when a marked, Sheriff's Office, vehicle pulled up behind her vehicle and a Deputy exited, in full uniform, and initiated contact with her and her friend. She said that this occurred on October 26, 2022, at approximately 0100 hours to 0130 hours. She stated that the Deputy told them they were not allowed to be there when the business was not open.

J.A. stated that the Deputy had a brief conversation with her friend and released him. She stated that the Deputy identified himself, by name, as Steven Abreu. She stated that he asked for her identification and asked her what her phone number was. She provided the information he requested and he wrote her information in a notebook that she saw him take out of his uniform vest pocket. She stated that he instructed her to get out of her vehicle, stating he wanted to check for illegal substances. She complied and described that he did not search her vehicle but proceeded to "frisk" her. She stated that he used his hands to grab her breasts and then grabbed her buttocks. She stated that he then told her to get back into her vehicle, which she did. She said that he then leaned into the open driver's side window, keeping his flashlight on and in his right hand. She said he then moved his left hand under her pants and penetrated her vagina with his fingers. She stated that he then began touching her breasts, under her clothing, with his left hand.

J.A. stated that she did not consent to any of the sexual acts. She stated that she did not feel free to leave and was fearful of what would happen if she did try to run away or fight him. J.A. said that her friend called her to check on her and she told Abreu it was her babysitter, and that she had kids at home waiting for her and she was late, hoping he would end the assault and let her leave. She stated that he wrote his phone number on a piece of paper and gave it to her before he let her go.

J.A. stated that Abreu called her phone and sent her several text messages from the number that he had

written on the paper for her. She stated that she did not answer his phone call and did not respond to his text messages. She stated that she deleted the text message before opening it, but did see what it said. She said the message said something of a sexual nature. She said that she then blocked his number.

J.A. stated that the following Friday, October 28, 2022, at approximately 2252 hours, she was traveling home from her place of employment and noticed a marked, Sheriff's Office vehicle, behind her on the road. She stated that she was speaking to her fiance, utilizing the hands-free system in her vehicle, and told him that she knew it was the same Deputy and that he was following her. She said that he turned on his emergency lights and she pulled over at Route 13 NB and Foskey Lane, Delmar, MD 21875. She stated that he initially approached on the passenger side of the vehicle and checked the car with his flashlight as he approached. She stated that he then acted like he didn't know it was her prior to stopping her. She said he told her that he had stopped her for having a tag light out. She said that he went back toward his car and was gone for several seconds. She stated that she thought he was checking her lights. She said that he then came back to the driver side of the car and spoke to her there.

She said that she told him she only had a few minutes to get to the store to get diapers for her child, before the store closed. She said he asked her why she didn't go to a different store, closer to her job, before heading in the direction of her home, indicating he had been watching her prior to her leaving from work and knew where she had gone.

She stated that he reached in to the vehicle and grabbed her face, in the area of her jawline, with his hand. She stated that he forcefully moved her face and looked at her neck. She said he commented on marks, that he had seen on her neck during the first assault, no longer being visible. She said that he then let her go and told her that he would see her again and that she was not to tell anyone about their interactions.

J.A. said that the next day, Saturday, October 29, 2022, she was so fearful of Abreu returning to her place of employment that her fiancé drove her to work and dropped her off. She said that her fiancé then arrived to pick her up at approximately 2213 hours. Upon his arrival to the parking lot at 2750 N. Salisbury Blvd., Salisbury, MD 21801, he observed a marked, Sheriff's Office, patrol vehicle in the parking lot with the headlights on. He videoed his vehicle, showing all of it's lights operational, and included the patrol vehicle in the video. He then observed the vehicle leave and go to an adjacent gas station and park next to a gas pump. J.A. left work, and went home and had no further interaction with Abreu that day.

At approximately 1637 hours on Sunday, October 30, 2022 I, Detective C. Kirkpatrick, conducted a recorded interview with Steven Abreu at the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office. Abreu was advised of his Constitutional Rights and agreed to speak with me. In the first part of the interview Abreu made numerous statements that I knew to be untrue.

These falsities include the following: stating that he recognized J.A.'s friend from a distance, because he was also a friend of his, and that was his reason for approaching them; that J.A. and her friend were released from the encounter at the same time and left together; that no portion of his interaction on the traffic stop was conducted with his camera systems turned off; and he denied having any contact with her in any way since the traffic stop.

The friend had been interviewed and stated that he did not know Abreu from any part of his life and that the detention in the Kohl's parking lot was the first time he could remember ever seeing him. He also stated that he was released from the stop and left prior to J.A. being released.

During the recorded interview with J.A. a single-party consent call was conducted and recorded. In that call Abreu spoke to J.A. about the incident and apologized 3 separate times. Abreu also admitted that he had turned off the camera systems in his car and his body-worn camera after the initial approach and prior to engaging in the conversation at the driver side door of J.A.'s vehicle.

NOTICE OF ADVICE OF RIGHT TO COUNSEL FOR ALL JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

- 1. This paper charges you with committing a crime.
- 2. If you have been arrested and remain in custody, you have the right to have a judicial officer decide whether you should be released from jail until your trial.
- 3. If you have been served with a citation or summons directing you to appear before a judicial officer for a preliminary inquiry at a date and time designated or within five days of service if no time is designated, a judicial officer will advise you of your rights, the charges against you, and penalties. The preliminary inquiry will be cancelled if a lawyer has entered an appearance to represent you.
- 4. You have the right to have a lawyer.
- 5. A lawyer can be helpful to you by:
 - (A) explaining the charges in this paper;
 - (B) telling you the possible penalties;
 - (C) helping you at trial;
 - (D) helping you protect your constitutional rights; and
 - (E) helping you to get a fair penalty if convicted.
- 6. Even if you plan to plead guilty, a lawyer can be helpful.
- 7. If you are eligible, the Public Defender or a court-appointed attorney will represent you at any initial appearance before a judicial officer and at any proceeding under Rule 4-216.1 to review an order of a District Court commissioner regarding pretrial release. If you want a lawyer for any further proceeding, including trial, but do not have the money to hire one, the Public Defender may provide a lawyer for you. The court clerk will tell you how to contact the Public Defender.
- 8. If you want a lawyer but you cannot get one and the Public Defender will not provide one for you, contact the court clerk as soon as possible.
- 9. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DATE OF YOUR TRIAL TO GET A LAWYER. If you do not have a lawyer before the trial date, you may have to go to trial without one.
