

RE: Revised COVID-19 Directive for Vaccination, Testing and Face Coverings

After consultation with the Delaware Division of Public Health, I am revising the College's interim COVID-19 policies as set forth below. These revisions are in accordance with recent guidance and recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the State of Delaware. This amendment is effective March 2, 2022, and is subject to change.

1. The employee vaccination and testing requirements initiated by order of Governor John Carney are lifted.
2. The vaccination requirements for students and visitors adopted by Delaware Tech are lifted. Even though the College is not requiring vaccinations for students, a COVID-19 vaccination may still be required by an external site where a student has been placed for a clinical or internship experience.
3. Face coverings are not required to be worn by individuals who enter in or upon a College property, except for individuals when indoors on College property located in a county where face coverings are recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDCP"). In accordance with CDCP guidance, individuals should continue to wear a face covering based on their personal preference; when they are immunocompromised or at risk of severe illness; or when they live or have social contact with someone who is immunocompromised or at risk of severe illness.
4. The most recent directives regarding self-screening, reporting positive cases/contact tracing, and isolation and quarantine remain in effect until further notice.
