## Greenberg's statement today shows why he should not be elected Mayor of Louisville

I have reviewed Mr. Greenberg's statement released today. It is a perfect indicator for why he should not be elected Mayor of Louisville. There are several statements that are familiar to me — because they're mine. He's copying my proven leadership to try to prove that he is more capable at running a city than he actually is.

At the start of his statement today, my opponent talks about how there should be no more studies but action — one of my campaign points since the summer of 2021. He also uses the term Day One throughout the document. I have been using Ready Day One in my campaign for more than a year. My opponent has made these mistakes even though he's paid consultants a lot of money to advise him. This is what he comes up with? He doesn't have anything original to say because he has no experience as a Mayor or elected official of any kind.

Public safety is the most critical objective involved in turning Louisville around. My opponent can say he has plans to do that. But how?
