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County Facilities Temporarily Closed to the Public

Elizabethtown, Ky. – Hardin County Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry directed all county facilities to close to the public effective at 4:30 pm Tuesday.

“Out of an abundance of caution and in following Centers for Disease Control guidance, I have ordered the closure to the public of all Hardin County owned facilities until further notice,” said Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry. “All employees will continue to report for duty to conduct business for our citizens and we will accept appointment requests for time-sensitive business.”
