

\$1.3 BILLION

in combined cannabis use sales revenue at the end of 2023.

\$3.84 MILLION

transferred to state agencies from adult-use revenue as outlined by the state's constitution. Adult use is split three ways: veterans support, drug addiction treatment programs and the Missouri Public Defender Systems budget.

\$13 MILLION

transferred from medical marijuana sales to support veterans. The Missouri Veterans Commission is likely to recieve \$19 million before July 1, 2024, when the current fiscal year ends. To date the commission has recieved nearly \$40 million in medical marijuana sales revenue.

All of this makes Missouri the nation's **6TH LARGEST** cannabis market.
