Patios and pavilions provide excellent views of outdoor horse activities and an air-conditioned lounge offers comfortable viewing of indoor riding.

For a riding enthusiast, there’s nothing better than Ridgefield Camp. Both one-day and multi-day options are available on the following dates: March 15 (spring break), June 12, June 27-28 (intermediate camp), July 17, July 26, and Aug. 7. Act fast as these dates will fill quickly.
