Born in Tuskegee, ALABAMA (18-Across), Rosa Parks was named for her two grandmothers, who were named ROse and LouiSA. In 1804, under the command of Stephen Decatur, the crew of the KETCH (47-Across) “Intrepid” destroyed an American frigate previously captured by Barbary pirates. In its original meaning, MIGHT AND MAIN (49-Across) was a deliberate redundancy, “main” being an archaic word for “strength.”
