week period. Most students attend twice per week, alternating between English/reading and math/science. Nationwide, Huntington students average a 5.4-point increase on their ACT, with local results often exceeding that benchmark.

Beyond admissions, higher test scores can translate directly into increased scholarships. "We can often move a student from a score of 25 to a 30," David said. "That kind of improvement can double or triple automatic scholarship awards overnight."

In addition to test prep, Huntington Learning Center offers academic skills programs for students kindergarten through 12th grade, as well as subject-specific tutoring for advanced high school courses.
