If you haven't been into **Charro Mexican Restaurant** in a while it's time to drop in for an authentic Mexican meal and a pitcher of Margaritas. You'll likely see a few new faces among Charro's friendly wait staff and a few new items on the menu.

Owner Ezequiel Camacho suggests trying the Molcajete Mar Tierra, a newly added menu item that represents the land and the sea. A traditional lava rock bowl is filled with grilled chicken, shrimp, tilapia and scallops served with salsa verde, Charro beans and fresh tortillas.

If you prefer land to sea, Ezequiel recommends the Birria Tacos made from meat that has been slowly simmered in a flavorful broth until it has achieved melt-in-your-mouth perfection. The flavorful broth is served alongside the tacos for dipping. Think Mexican magic meets the French Dip.

"We have five new dishes on the menu," Ezequiel said. But fans of his mother's and sister's family recipes shouldn't worry. Charro still offers a menu laden with Camacho family favorites. "It's hard to pass up Enchiladas Suizas, which features my mother's signature spice blend."

Enchiladas Suizas can be ordered traditionally with chicken or filled with slices of beef. In either preparation, the meats are grilled and seasoned to perfection. While enchiladas often are made with shredded chicken, Camacho cuts his filling into bite-sized pieces that are coated on all sides with seasoning.

The restaurant also features a fully stocked bar that carries American and Mexican brews and 30 types of tequila. Outside on the patio as the weather cools down or inside the cozy restaurant, Charro is the perfect place to gather with friends and family for good food, good drink and good times.



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
