The word **SEPIA** (32-Across) comes from the Latin word for the cuttlefish, whose secretion was the original source of the brown pigment. **BOISE**, Idaho (60-Across) was founded as a military outpost in the 1860s, and grew rapidly due its location on the Oregon Trail. **ASLAN** (77-Across), the talking lion in C.S. Lewis' "Chronicles of Narnia," is the only character appearing in all seven of its chronicles.
