The 9 a.m. Traditional Worship service features hymns, liturgy and choir, while the 10:30 a.m. Contemporary Worship service includes modern worship music led by a praise band. Children's ministries are available during both services.

Throughout the week, members connect through Bible studies, small groups and music ministries. This fall, the congregation will participate in the churchwide study, Emotionally Healthy Spirituality.

Members also serve the community by volunteering with Circle of Concern, participating in Feed the Need STL, collecting school supplies and supporting neighbors in need.

The Early Childhood Center has served families for more than three decades, while children's and youth ministries provide worship, service projects, camps, retreats and special events.
