As of August 22, 2022, Chief Faulkenburg informed us is that the police and federal agencies have located Kendall in Jacksonville, Florida. Kendall is expected to be returned to us within the next five days. While we want to rush to her side and fly her straight home, there are a bunch of legal hoops we have to jump through in order to get her home safe and sound. We have waited 33 days to know she is safe, we will eagerly work with the authorities to get her back home to southern Indiana as soon as possible.

We will continue to keep the community updated on how Kendall is doing. We want to thank each and every person, business, or group who stepped up and helped in our search for Kendall. You are all heroes to us. Too often today, we think communities and people are too polarized and divided. I hope you all look at all we have done and realize that when it came to the life of one young woman, you showed up for her so we could come together as a cohesive group of people with a singular mind to bring Kendall home successfully.

I want to personally give the well-earned credit to the Santa Claus Police department under Chief Faulkenburg. There was not one step of this process or one tiny clue that was ignored or brushed aside. As someone who has come from a large city, this is a police force in which we should all take great pride in calling neighbors or friends. The members of law enforcement in this area and in the surrounding counties, cities, and towns all stepped up to every request made by Chief Faulkenburg and his officers. They stood with us and because of their efforts, we will have a happy reunion with Kendall in the coming days.

There are so many businesses, organizations, and people to thank I will need some time to make a list. It is my intention to make a comprehensive post later this week detailing the local businesses, organizations, any people who have gone above and beyond to help us bring our daughter home. For those who helped us, donated time or materials, and spent countless hours talking about her or praying for our family, this news release would not have been possible without your help. We are truly humbled by your support and kindness.

Over the next several days and weeks, our family will be rallying around Kendall to make sure she has access to the help and services she needs to start healing. We ask but one more thing of you all; please remember Kendall and our family in your prayers. We ask that you please remember that finding Kendall or any missing person is but the beginning of the journey. Please lift our family and Kendall up in prayer during this time. You are welcome to continue to reach out to us, post positive messages or

comments to Kendall, and share pictures or videos. Kendall needs to see how much her community cares for her as one of their own not just when she is missing but also when she is home.
