

Boil Water Order – Lynnville, Indiana

Boil water for five minutes before cooking or drinking

The Town of Lynnville is issuing a Boil Water Order for customers of the town water system after a water sample from the town water tower tested positive for E. coli bacteria. A routine sample tested on Tuesday, May 9, was found to contain coliform bacteria, and a follow-up test confirmed the presence of E. coli, which may cause potential health effects if consumed.

The Boil Water Order requires water customers to bring all cooking and drinking water to a complete boil for five minutes before using. Veolia North America, which operates Lynnville's water system, is working closely with the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) to remedy the situation and protect public health. Under IDEM guidance, Veolia North America will continue testing water samples, and when two samples taken 24 hours apart are both satisfactory, the Boil Water Order can be lifted.
