# Community Vision

In August of 2019, the *Impact Jasper Comprehensive Plan* was adopted as the official "roadmap" guiding the City of Jasper's vision over the course of the next 10 years. Through significant public engagement, key priorities of the Plan included:

- Attract and retain workforce talent by providing additional health, wellness, and recreational amenities.
- Become a fitness-friendly community by increasing access to nutrition and physical activity options.
- Significantly expand program opportunities for families, teen, seniors, and the winter season.
- Focus on a regional mindset, not a local community.

The concept of building a new comprehensive Regional Wellness Center on the ten-acre site adjacent to the Parklands, National Guard Armory, and Jasper's outdoor pool came into focus. The Tri-County YMCA, Memorial Hospital & Health Care Center, and the Indiana National Guard became major collaborative partners!

Hundreds of hours of engagement and discussion led to a vision for the new Regional Wellness Center & Recreation Campus including a 90,000 square foot facility to provide comprehensive programming for children, adults, families, and seniors; indoor regional aquatics center; outdoor aquatics venue, and preserved outdoor recreation amenities at Jaycee Park.







## Floor Plans










