



Walmart Hosts COVID-19 Community Vaccine Event in Reading

Events designed to provide access to the vaccine to those most vulnerable to COVID-19

Reading, PA. March 16th, 2021 – Walmart will begin administering Pfizer COVID-19 vaccines in Berks County with a clinic inside the gymnasium of the **Lausch Administration Building of the Exeter Township School District from Wednesday, March 24th- Friday, March 26th**. The Lausch Building is located at 200 Elm St., Reading, PA 19606.

Eligible patients can schedule a vaccine appointment by calling **1-800-753-8827, option 1, 8:30am-5pm Monday through Friday**, making it convenient to get vaccinated while vaccine supplies last. Vaccines will be available to those who meet the current phase of vaccine eligibility in Pennsylvania which can be found at health.pa.gov. Insurance is not required, there is no cost to receive the vaccine, and appointments for the second vaccination will be made while at the first appointment.

We ask that people interested in receiving the vaccine please **do not call the Exeter Township School District or show up without an appointment.** Please call **1-800-753-8827, option 1.**
