



## IRON MENACE FACT SHEET

### PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS

**Track Length:** 2,169 feet

**Lift Height:** 160 feet

**Angle of Descent:** 95 degrees

### FEATURES

The ride layout is custom designed for Dorney Park, featuring a track and train that provide a first for riders in the Northeast. Other elements of the ride include:

- **Lift Hill** – riders climb 160 feet, then drop down at a record tying 95-degree angle.
- **3 Second Hold** – Passengers will be suspended, looking straight down before a sudden release into the beyond 95 degree drop.
- **Immelmann** – a maneuver that takes riders into a half-loop followed by a half twist before exiting the element traveling in the opposite direction making a 180-degree turn.
- **Zero G-Roll** – the track twists 360 degrees as it rises and falls in elevation, giving riders the weightless effect of zero g-force.
- **Tilted Loop** – Also known as an inclined loop, the train enters while banked hurtling riders along the track at a unique angle. (A Dive Coaster First).
- **360 Degree Flat Spin** – Riders go spinning through the corkscrew element.
