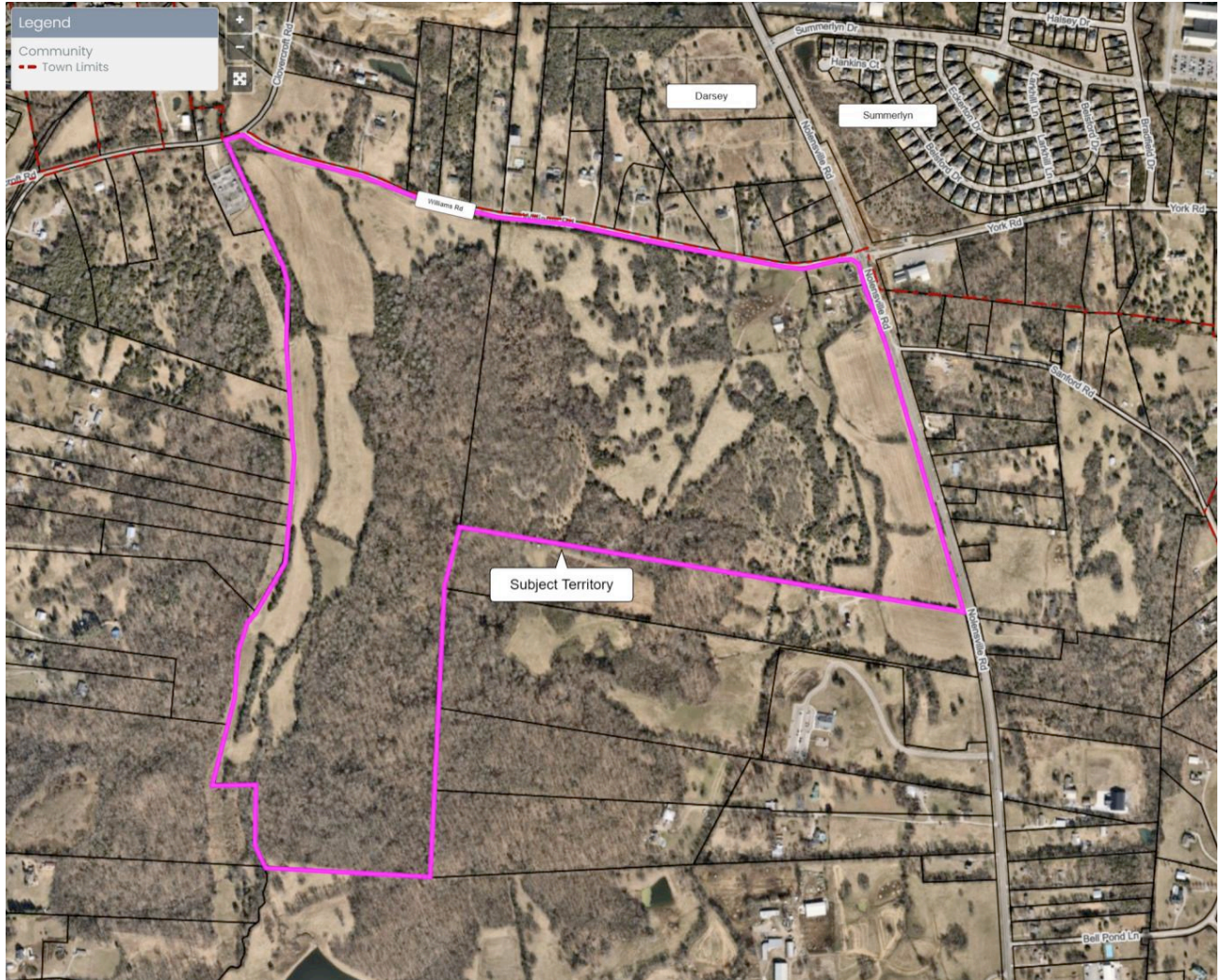
Individuals who wish to speak during the public hearing must sign the public comment sheet provided immediately prior to the start of the hearing.
