AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING WINONA CITY
CODE, CHAPTERS 25, 51
AND 55, ESTABLISHING
TEMPORARY
PERMITTED USE OF
PUBLIC SIDEWALK
AND RIGHT OF WAY TO
EXPAND RETAIL AND
COMMERCIAL SALES
AND SERVICE AREAS**

SUMMARY: Ordinance No. 4313 amends Winona City Code, Chapters 25, 51 and 55, establishing a regulatory process and rules, conditions and regulations, among other changes, for businesses in certain designated zoning districts to apply to the City for a temporary permit for the use of public sidewalks and rights of way in order to expand retail and commercial outdoor food and beverage sales and service in permitted areas directly adjacent to and contiguous with an

otherwise existing business premises, and additionally, as applicable, including expansion of a liquor licensed premises pursuant to a separate, additional permitting process. The Ordinance also makes additional changes to City Code allowing for the temporary uses authorized as well as violation, and establishes fees for the various encroachment permits established in the Ordinance.
