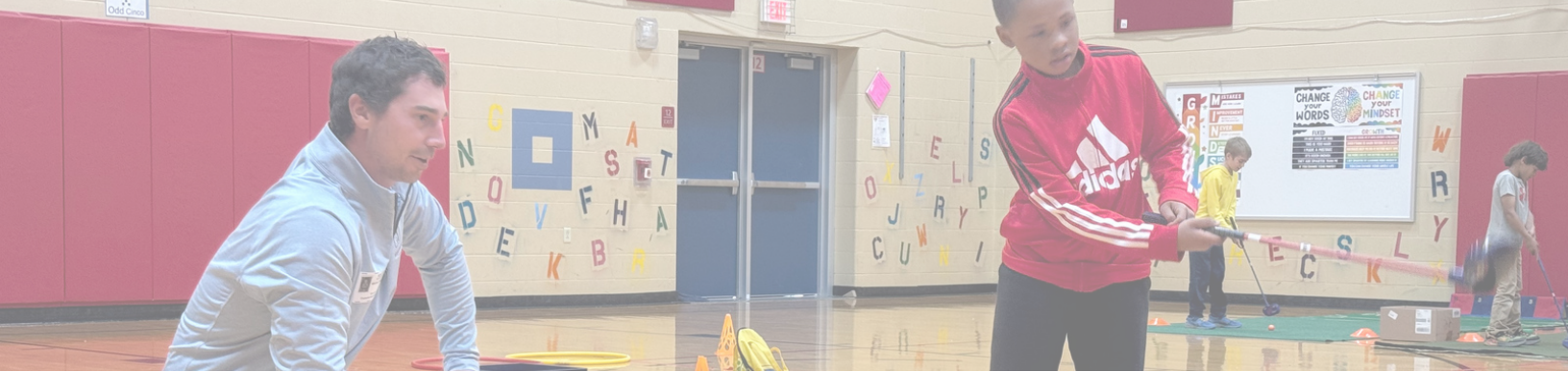

## Inner-City Girls Golf Academy

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The Inner-City Girls Golf Academy will focus on 7th-12th grade females that are associated with Madison East and Madison LaFollette. Over the last few years neither one of these schools had enough interest to field a team. Our goal is to introduce more girls to the game of golf and develop them into golfers, so they feel comfortable to join the team. These young females will be taught self-confidence that will help them succeed on and off the course. Any female between the grades of 7th and 12th that will be or is attending Madison East or Madison LaFollette is offered an invitation to learn the game at no charge. Weekly coaching and training programs will be offered in June, July, and August.





## Rural Area Girls Golf Academy

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The Rural Area Girls Golf Academy will focus on 7th-12th grade females that are associated with the Heart O' North Conference in northern Wisconsin. These schools include Ashland, Barron, Chetek, Cameron, Cumberland, Hayward, Ladysmith, Northwestern, Spooner, and St. Croix Falls. These schools have limited access to PGA Professionals for golf instruction. We will provide opportunities for these females to attend a high-level golf academy focusing on developing golfers. These girls will receive access to virtual online golf coaching throughout the remainder of the year.

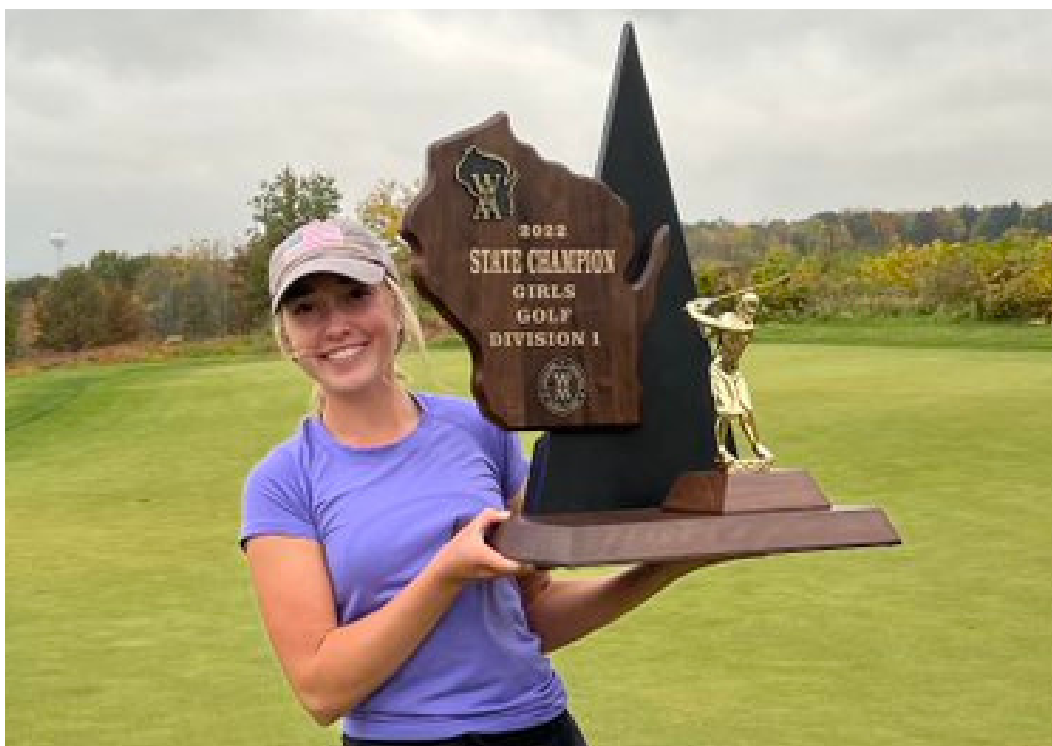




## Competitive Girls Golf Academy

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This high-level coaching and training academy is open to competitive high school or college females. This academy will consist of improving all facets of playing competitive golf, concluding with an 18-hole tournament at TPC Wisconsin. Learn from some of Wisconsin's best golf resources about playing, practicing, swing techniques, fitness, and mental training.





## Golfer Give Back Program

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The Golfer Give Back program developed by the GFW is designed to contribute to a school's food pantry that helps feed families in need. The golf component will include introducing golf to a specific grade within the school. In addition to the kids getting a chance to learn the game of golf, two students will receive a scholarship to participate in golf programs at TPC Wisconsin. The participants will be outfitted with all of the needed equipment to participate.





## Growing and Supporting Women's Golf

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Another mission of the GFW is to assist in growing women in the game of golf. To assist with this we will partner with the LPGA Amateur Association Madison Chapter and offer golf clinics that focus on fundamentals, fitness practices, club fitting and playing the game. The GFW will act as a sponsor to the National Women's Golf Day event held at TPC Wisconsin on June 8, 2024.

The GFW will be involved with the UW-Whitewater Women's Golf Invitational. This event will be held in September of 2024 and will field 100 female collegiate golfers. With our assistance, the golfers will be able to enjoy playing on a tour championship golf course, which school budgets do not typically allow.

## WPGA Junior Foundation “Cup Matches”

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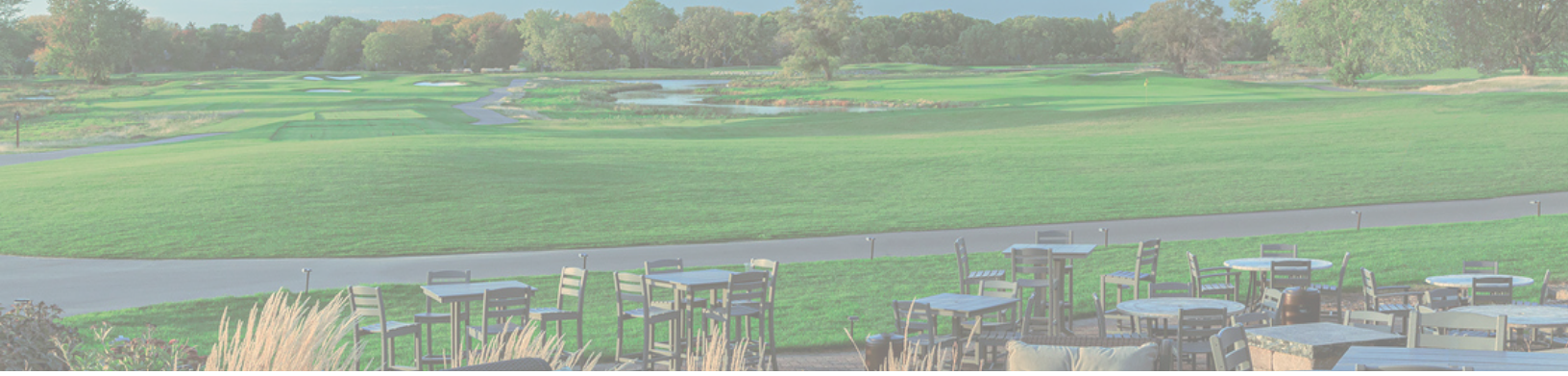
