

**Message to Families:  
January 10, 2022**

Dear Parents and Guardians:

We have had a number of positives for COVID again this morning. Our numbers with positive tests for COVID have been increasing for the past week and are building wide. As a result, we will move to **virtual instruction** for the remainder of this week. We will dismiss all students at 12:30 today and additional information with instruction will be communicated this afternoon.

Our plan at this time is to return to in-person instruction on Monday, January 17, 2022. We will continue to monitor the number of positive cases and if we need to take some additional days we will inform you by the end of this week.

We ask that you continue to help us monitor our students as we make decisions with our return to in-person instruction. If there is a change in status with you or any family members, please let us know. Providing information with positive tests or contact with someone that has tested positive will help us make the decision with return to in-person instruction. Antigen testing (rapid) will be available at the school Monday-Friday. PCR testing will be available for our families on Friday this week. Please call ahead of time to schedule an appointment if you would like your family tested. Thank you for working with us.
