**Re: Letter Suspending Approval of State Electric Vehicle Deployment Plans**

Dear Ms. Biondi:

As Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, moving Kentucky forward is my job. One way we are doing that is building the infrastructure for electric vehicles. The National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Formula Program provides federal funding that is crucial to that effort.

We received your February 6, 2025 letter regarding the NEVI Formula Program. Your letter states that as a result of the rescindment of the NEVI Formula Program Guidance, the Federal Highway Administration has ceased all new obligations under the program. However, you assure that until new guidance is issued, **reimbursement of existing obligations will be allowed** in order to not disrupt current financial commitments.

As of today, the Federal Highway Administration has obligated a total of \$32,870,351.10 to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet of the \$69.5 million in federal NEVI formula funding that Kentucky should receive under the program. These obligated funds have led to Kentucky issuing three separate requests for proposals to contract with vendors. The funding for these separate projects is as follows:

- Request for Proposal 1: \$15,423,951.00
- Request for Proposal 2: \$8,828,391.10
- Request for Proposal 3: \$8,618,009.00
- Total: \$32,870,351.10.

Based on your letter, Kentucky will expect you to honor your commitment concerning these obligated funds as we await new guidance for the remaining dollars.
