I. CONSENT AGENDA

It is ordered to approve the Consent Agenda for March 23, 2026, McCracken County Fiscal Court.

II. BUDGET TRANSFERS

It is ordered that the necessary cash transfers, in the amount of \$375,000.00 be made in order to pay County bills and payroll approved March 12, 2026.

It is ordered to approve the Voucher Claims Register from March 12, 2026, to March 23, 2026, to show County bills in the amount of \$103,061.95 were paid.

V. COURT ORDERS

- A. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign the agreement with the Purchase Area Development District (PADD) defining the local match for the Metropolitan Transportation Planning (MPO) in the amount of \$4126.50. It is further ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to pay invoices related to the same.
- B. It is ordered that the County Judge Executive is authorized to sign an Agreement of Affiliation with the West Kentucky Crime Stoppers that authorizes a \$1.00 fee added to court cost in McCracken County. The fee is collected and distributed by the Circuit Court Clerk as required by KRS 431.597.
- C. It is ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to pay Lone Oak Trophy House in the amount of \$45.00 for service award. The cost is from the federal drug forfeiture fund.
- D. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated March 3, 2026, to Deere & Company for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$35,923.40. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- E. It is ordered that the York central unit from the former Bluegrass Downs property, model ZR300S30E2B5NCD2M1 and serial number N1F6693064, is declared as surplus.
- F. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to execute the Amended Memorandum of Understanding between the Fiscal Court and the McCracken County Jailer. The amended MOU allows for additional funds from the jail to pay for medical expenses.
- G. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign resolutions and documents as they relate to Anti-Displacement Plan, Procurement Standards and Fair Housing to establish compliance in the administration of the Four Rivers Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).
- H. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign an agreement with Four Rivers CenterPoint Behavioral Health for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

An Ordinance amending McCracken County Ordinance No. 2025-08 by making revisions to the proposed Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Operating Budget by modifications in receipts from Sheriff Insurance Proceeds, Sheriff Miscellaneous, DOJ Drug Forfeiture, E911 Fee Prior Year Surplus and Debt Adjusted Prior Year Surplus in strict compliance with the mandates of Kentucky Revised Statutes Chapter 68.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 911 PARCEL FEE
ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 2024-06**

Summary: The present Ordinance revises McCracken County Ordinance 2024-06 by removing the "public use unit" status from government assisted housing and medical facilities. Further, by clarifying that stand alone residential garages are assessed the residential parcel fee. Additionally, by changing the term occupied to occupiable, in determining the status of property required to

pay the parcel fee. Lastly, by adding the 911 Parcel Fee Appeals Board Hearing Procedure to the ordinance and adding an explicit due process right to appeal the parcel fee to District Court.
