Veteran's Day Celebration

Distinguished Veteran Award 2019 Criteria

The purpose of the **Distinguished Veteran Award** is to <u>give recognition</u> to a **Veteran** who has not received any noted awards from his/her community. Nominees submitted, will be considered by the 2019 Veterans' Celebration Board after the Friday, <u>October 11th deadline</u>. The Distinguished Veteran Award will be presented at the ceremonies for the Veterans' Day Celebration at the Expo Center on November 11.

Selection of the Distinguished Veteran will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. <u>Veterans</u> who reside in Paducah/ McCracken County will be given priority over other counties.
- 2. <u>Veterans</u> with service from the Korean War and WWII will be given **priority** also since their age gives us only a limited time to honor them.
- 3. Nomination forms will be made available to the media by Paducah Parks & Recreation and will request that they include:
 - a. Service Records
 - b. Community Service Records
 - c. Family History
 - d. DD214 Copies
 - e. Military Service Records
 - f. History of awards, medals or service beyond the call of duty
- 4. The service record will be a contributing factor, but personal comments by family and friends will hold importance too.
- 5. The winner will be selected by the Veterans' Day celebration board. Review of the applications will be made by this appointed board and the selection will remain a secret, until the award presentation.
- 6. The <u>nominator</u> of the selected winner <u>will be contacted and asked to make sure the winner is</u> <u>present at the parade and ceremony to receive the award.</u>
- 7. The winner will be announced and receive an award at the Ceremony and will be able to follow the grand marshal in a carriage/car provided by Parks & Recreation/sponsor. The winner must have someone to ride/drive with them in the provided carriage/car in the parade.

- 2. Family, friends and veteran organizations are encouraged to nominate someone who fits the criteria for this award.
- 3. Nominees <u>DO NOT</u> have to be <u>associated with a veteran organization</u>, but must have extensive time and service dedicated to serving veterans and veteran causes.
